

MEAL MINISTRY A GREAT SUCCESS!

Last week, we successfully launched our Meal Ministry to our homebound parishioners. Thank you to Shari Chmura and all our volunteer ministers who helped by donating food, cooking meals, packaging food and delivering meals. We were able to provide over 30 meals to the homebound members of our parish. Stay tuned! The Meal Ministry will be delivering meals twice per month. Watch for upcoming opportunities to serve!

NEW MEN'S DISCIPLESHIP GROUP LAUNCHING SOON!

You all know by now that our mission at St. Columbkille is to Worship God, Serve Others, and Grow Disciples of Jesus. Growing as disciples of Jesus starts by gathering together for prayer and fellowship. One project that Eric Perusek from my staff has been working on this summer is the creation of a new men's discipleship group. The purpose of this group is to empower men to grow as disciples of Jesus Christ and lead others to Jesus.

Right now, the group is planning on meeting at two separate times: 1. Weekly Men's Discipleship Breakfasts on Wednesday morning from 6 AM - 7 AM in the Parish Center; 2. Monthly on the third Thursday of the month from 7 PM - 9 PM in the church basement. Men are welcome to attend both or choose one, they can come frequently or occasionally. We plan on launching this group beginning in September, so if you are interested in joining, please call the Parish Office or reach out to Eric by email at eperusek@stcolumbkillparish.org. More information will be coming in August so stay tuned!

Here is a breakdown of the format of the men's group meetings in case you are interested:

The three pillars of every meeting: Prayer, Sharing and Scripture/Faith Content

- **Prayer:** At the beginning and end of each meeting and whenever is needed in between.
- **Sharing:** Our faith, personal testimony, or insights that anyone feels prompted to bring up.
- **Scripture/Faith Content:** Each meeting will be anchored in Scripture or dynamic videos that explore its themes, motifs, and lessons.

Men's Discipleship Breakfasts

- · Weekly on Wednesday morning (6 AM 7 AM) launching in September with the content "**That Man is You**" as a way to draw men in a parish to grow deeper into their Catholic faith.
- · Content is compelling and clear but also relatable and easy to digest.
- · Mornings can be used to invite new men into the fold whether they are in the school or surrounding communities.
- · We will have bagels and coffee and fellowship after the meeting ends.

Men's Discipleship Evenings

- · Monthly on the third Thursday from 7 PM 9 PM in the church basement.
- · Focus on sacred Scripture and faith sharing.
- · Designed to encourage men to go deeper and give them chances to lead portions in small group discussion.
- · Snacks available before and after.

Wives and mothers, please share this information with your husbands or sons and encourage them to come check it out!

PARISH NEWS



In this week's Gospel, we have the well-known story of Mary & Martha. At first glance, I always thought this Gospel passage was unfair to Martha. Without her there would be no meal, no clean home, and, since Martha invited Him, no Jesus. Yet Jesus rebukes Martha and praises Mary since she has "chosen the better part." Upon reflection, I've come to believe that Jesus is not saying that Martha's work is unimportant, but that Mary's listening is the higher priority. Our lives require a balance of work and prayer and Jesus is urging us to keep prayer as our highest priority. As life changes and we potentially have new job

demands, children, or other responsibilities, life can feel overwhelming and busy. In those moments, we are likely tempted to be Martha, "burdened" by trying to get it all done. However, this does not excuse us from prayer. We cannot be Martha and become so focused on errands, housekeeping, and work that we excuse ourselves from daily prayer, sacrifices, and Sunday Mass. On the flip side, we cannot be Mary all the time and spend all day in Adoration or bills will not get paid, meals will not get cooked, and diapers will not get changed. For us to be holy in body, mind, and spirit, we need to find a healthy balance of prayer and work. This balance can only be found through vigilant prayer and discernment. This week, consider asking God for the grace to balance the prayer and receptivity of Mary with the work ethic and sacrifice of Martha in your own life.

Meal Ministry Friday, July 25



Cooking, Packing, and Delivering Meals to our Homebound Parishioners!

Meal preparation and deliveries will be made on the 2nd and 4th Fridays of every month (during the Season of Lent, delicious weekly meals from our fish fry will be delivered).

Interested in becoming involved in this new ministry? Whether once in a while or on a regular basis, all are welcome! Check out the Meal Ministry tab on the parish website.

Kitchen Worker: help prepare food and pack-up meals for delivery. Kitchen workers are needed for $1\frac{1}{2}$ hour shifts. The first shift is 1:30 - 3:00 p.m. and the second shift is 3:00 - 4:30 p.m.

Driver: Use your own vehicle to deliver meals. Drivers report to St. Columbkille at 4:15 p.m. on delivery day to pick up their meals. Routes/addresses will be given with meal pick up and should take a half hour to 45 minutes to complete. Children are welcome to accompany an adult on deliveries.

Bakers: Of course, dessert is included with our meals so help from our parish bakers is a must! Bake in your own home and drop-off at the St. Columbkille rectory office on Friday between 8:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.




