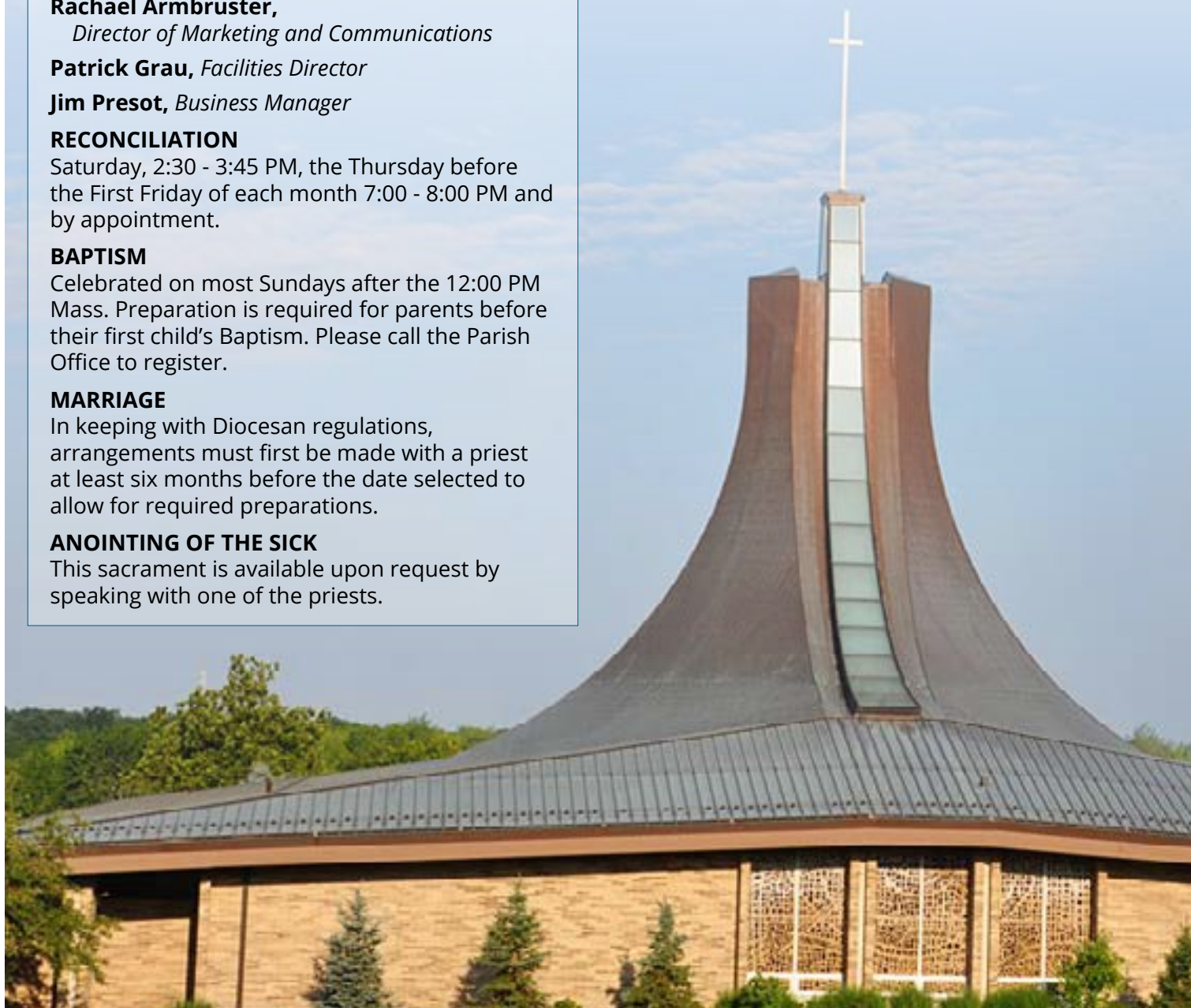

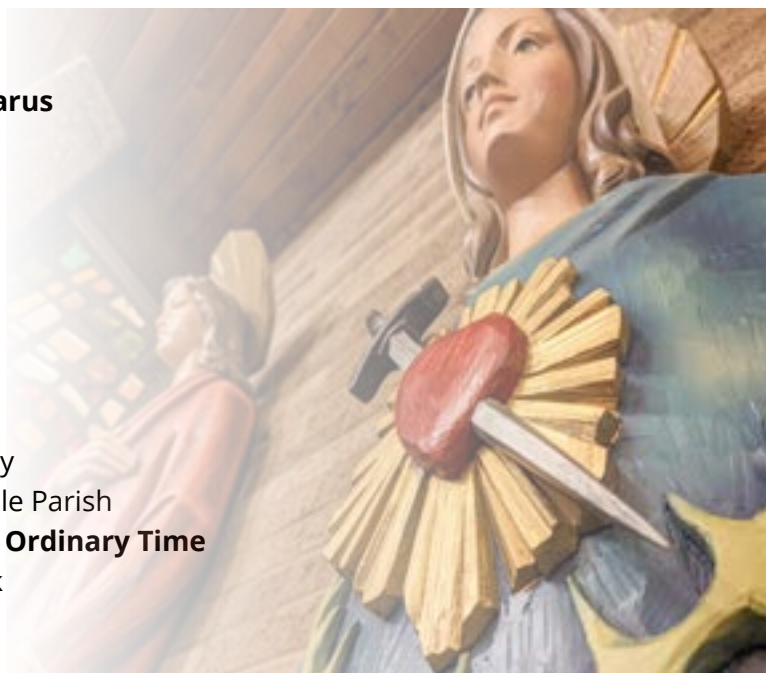

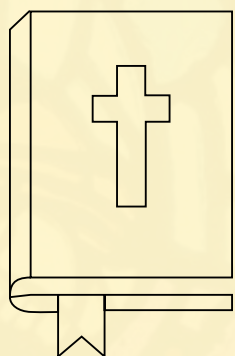

LETTER FROM THE PASTOR



PARENTS OF HOLY MOTHER MARY, PRAY FOR US!

Last week, the Church celebrated the Feast Day of Sts. Joachim and Anne on July 26th. Our Catholic tradition has always identified the parents of Mary, the Mother of God, as Joachim and Anne. This long-standing practice has its origin in the oral tradition of early Christianity which was later recorded in non-Scriptural texts such as the Gospel of James.

There, one finds some of the faith tradition of our earliest Christian ancestors which held that after years of childlessness, an angel appeared to Anne and Joachim to inform them that they would have a child. Anne promised to dedicate this child to God much the way that Samuel was dedicated to God by his mother Hannah in 1st Kings. We honor Joachim and Anne as the parents of Mary who nurtured her, taught her, and raised her to know, love, and trust God – so much so that she was properly disposed in mind and heart to be able to respond to what God asked of her through the Angel Gabriel:

“Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. Behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son and you shall call him Jesus...The Holy Spirit will come upon you and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. Therefore, the child to be born will be called holy, the Son of God.” Mary said, ‘Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word.’” (Luke 1:26-38)

It was the example of parenting that Mary must have received from Joachim and Anne that she followed as she raised Jesus. It was the faith they shared with her which laid the foundation of courage, strength, and trust which served her well even in the pain of standing at the foot of the cross as her Son was crucified. Joachim and Anne are models of inspiration for all parents and grandparents. It is in the spirit of Sts. Joachim and Anne that I offer this prayer and encouragement to all parents and grandparents to please continue bringing your children to Mass.

Prayer: Parents of Mary, Sts. Joachim and Anne, we pray for all parents and grandparents that they may provide the loving home and faithful teaching that you provided your daughter, Mary, the Mother of Jesus. Amen

NEW MEN'S DISCIPLESHIP GROUP LAUNCHING SOON!

You all know by now that our mission at St. Columbkille is to Worship God, Serve Others, and Grow Disciples of Jesus. Growing as disciples of Jesus starts by gathering together for prayer and fellowship. One project that Eric Perusek from my staff has been working on this summer is the creation of a new men's discipleship group. The purpose of this group is to empower men to grow as disciples of Jesus Christ and lead others to Jesus.

Right now, the group is planning on meeting at two separate times: 1. Weekly Men's Discipleship Breakfasts on Wednesday morning from 6 AM - 7 AM in the Parish Center: 2. Monthly on the third Thursday of the month from 7 PM - 9 PM in the church basement. Men are welcome to attend both or choose one, they can come frequently or occasionally. We plan on launching this group beginning in September, so if you are interested in joining, please call the Parish Office or reach out to Eric by email at eperusek@stcolumbkilleparish.org. More information will be coming in August, so stay tuned!

Here is a breakdown of the format of the men's group meetings in case you are interested:

The three pillars of every meeting: Prayer, Sharing and Scripture/Faith Content

- **Prayer:** At the beginning and end of each meeting and whenever is needed in between.
- **Sharing:** Our faith, personal testimony, or insights that anyone feels prompted to bring up.
- **Scripture/Faith Content:** Each meeting will be anchored in Scripture or dynamic videos that explore its themes, motifs, and lessons.

Men's Discipleship Breakfasts

- Weekly on Wednesday morning (6 AM - 7 AM) launching in September with the content **“That Man is You”** as a way to draw men in the parish to grow deeper into their Catholic faith.
- Content is compelling and clear but also relatable and easy to digest.
- Mornings can be used to invite new men into the fold whether they are in the school or surrounding communities.
- We will have bagels and coffee and fellowship after the meeting ends.

Men's Discipleship Evenings

- Monthly on the third Thursday from 7 PM - 9 PM in the church basement.

- Focus on Sacred Scripture and faith sharing.
- Designed to encourage men to go deeper and give them chances to lead portions in small group discussion.
- Snacks available before and after.

IS GOD CALLING YOU TO BECOME AN EXTRAORDINARY MINISTER OF HOLY COMMUNION?

You see them serving the Body and Blood of Christ every week at Mass and bringing Jesus to the sick and homebound in our community. Maybe you've thought about distributing Communion, but you have some questions. What are the proper qualifications of someone who is chosen to become a Minister of Holy Communion?

1. No person has the explicit right to serve as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion – you must be called by God, nominated and chosen by your pastor to participate in this sacred ministry.
2. Those chosen for this ministry are role models for the parish, living exemplary lives of faith as evidenced by their words, actions, participation in social media, etc.
3. They are participating regularly in the Sunday celebration of Holy Eucharist and believe wholeheartedly that the bread and wine become the Body, Blood, soul and divinity of Jesus Christ at Mass.
4. Those who are married must be in a sacramental marriage officially recognized by the Church.
5. They should feel a calling from God to serve Jesus to others, especially the sick, homebound or the dying.

St. Columbkille is hosting a diocesan training for new Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion on Thursday, September 18th at 7 PM in church. Before you can be trained, you must be nominated and chosen by Fr. Suso. If you meet these criteria and would like to be nominated by Fr. Suso to serve as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion, please email or call Jennifer, our parish office manager, at jgustoskey@stcolumbkilleparish.org or 216-524-1987, ext. 10.

PARISH NEWS



When I see people struggling with mental health issues, they understandably want to feel better. People do not like to be in pain, myself included, and suffering can be incredibly severe at times. I sometimes hear people struggle with this week's Gospel passage because they are asking for pain and suffering to be removed and they perceive that nothing is happening when things do not seem to get better. In their minds they might think that God has forgotten about them, the door is not open, and they have been handed the scorpion. As humans, we enjoy instant gratification and we want God to relieve our suffering in our time and on our terms. However, our mental health will suffer if we view God as a vending machine where we offer up prayers as currency and expect sadness, anger, or anxiety to disappear as fast as it takes the bag of Cheetos to fall from the top row. When our pain and suffering does not abruptly end, it is not because God does not love us or care about us anymore. Most of us can think of a time when we were upset with God because we did not get what we wanted only to discover that He had something better in store for us. Maybe this is the case for any present pain and suffering that we carry. Healing is a beautiful journey of insight, discovery, and self-actualization, but change takes time. Ask and you shall receive, but maybe in a way you have not considered. If you are struggling, remember that this Gospel passage is for you.

PARISH REGISTRATION

Whether you are new to our parish community or have been here for many years, have you taken time to formally register at our parish? Maybe you moved recently, or an adult child moved out of your house, did you update your registration? There are lots of benefits to registering!

Sense of Belonging and Identity in Christ:

Registration helps you feel more connected to the parish and school community, allowing you to find a spiritual family and a place to call home.

Allows for Pastoral Care and Communication:

Registering helps the pastor and staff to welcome, know and minister to you and your family, especially during significant moments in your life like – birth, baptisms, weddings, First Communions, and funerals. It also helps the parish stay connected, providing information via email, text messaging, phone or traditional mail.

Eligibility for Ministry Roles:

Registration can be a requirement for participation in certain ministry roles like being a sponsor for confirmation or a godparent for baptism.

Financial Benefits:

Registered members may receive year-end financial statements for tax purposes and may be eligible for discounts or other benefits related to parish activities.

Access to the Sacraments:

Registration is very helpful for receiving sacraments like Baptism, Reconciliation, First Communion, Confirmation and Holy Matrimony.

Commitment to Faith:

Registration demonstrates to the community your commitment to your faith and participating in the life of the church.



Parish Planning and Resources:

Accurate Census numbers from parish registrations help the diocese and our parish in planning for future needs. The greater number of registered households we have the greater likelihood of getting additional priests and/or deacons at our parish!

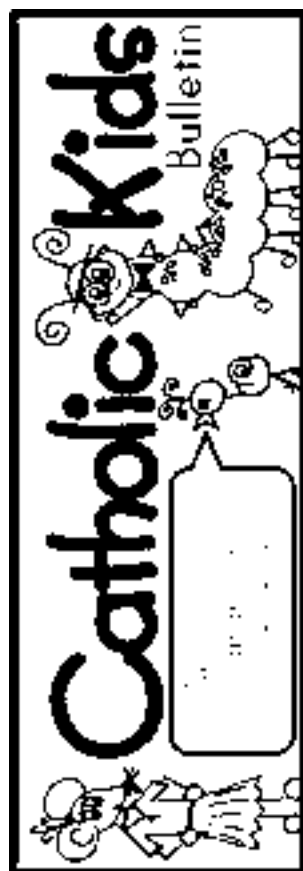

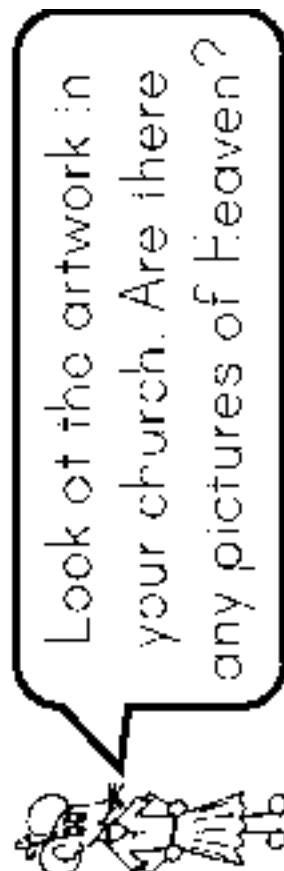

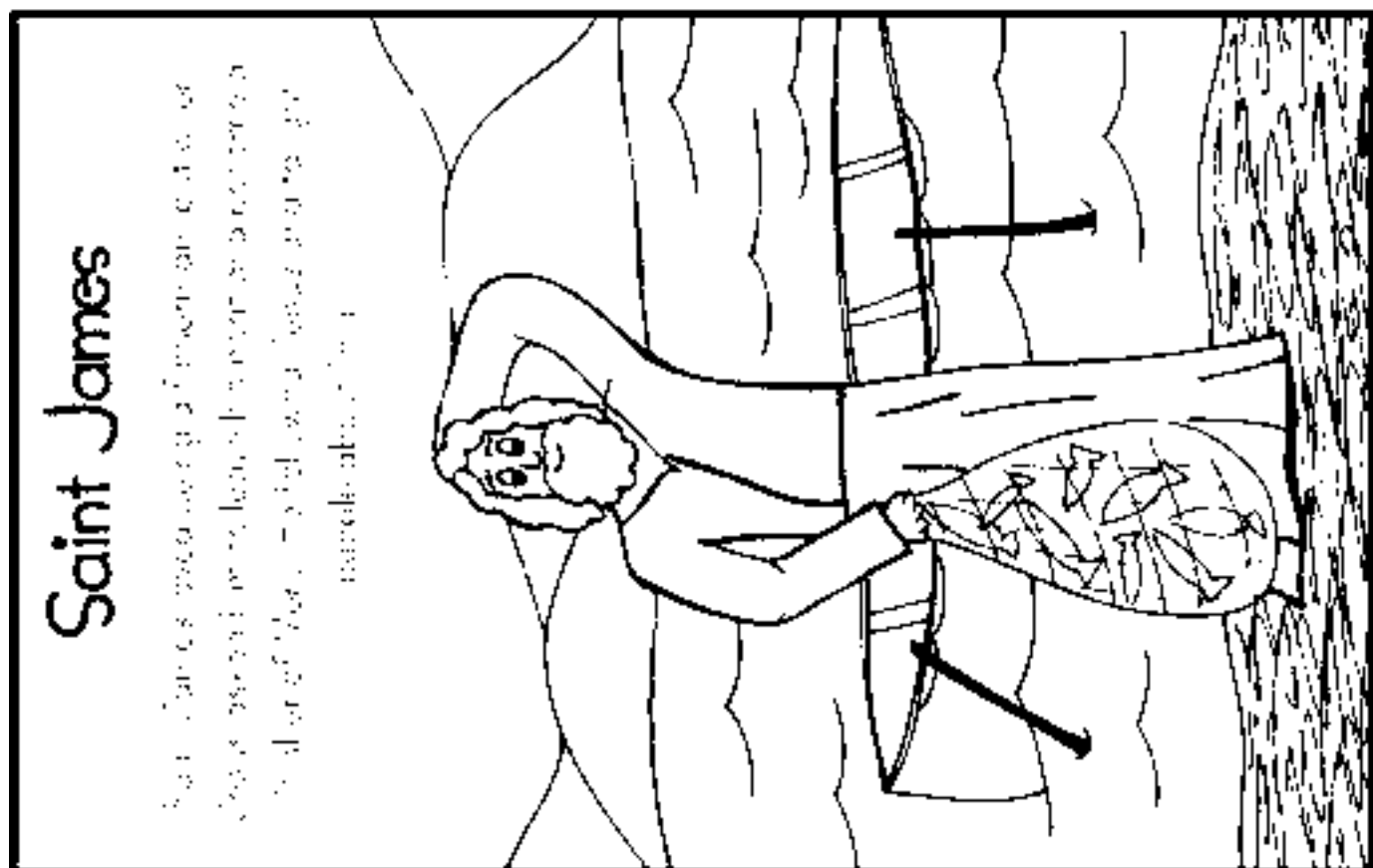
