A Few Of The New Graduates

English as a Second Language (ESL)/ Bible School:


We have begun our efforts to expand our student body by hiring a new administrator and advertising on social media. We have begun a new discipleship program and are meeting with graduates each week for a snack and Gospel discussion. We are attempting to answer all their questions from what they learned in the Bible portion of ESL, to find if they have made a decision for Christ, if they have a church and questions about serving. We also just had our graduation. A picture of a small group of the graduates is above. We had over 60 grads and over 200 students last year. This summer 2025 semester we have the largest class of Intermediate students ever, a 15 week intense course through the Gospel. One thing we ask as a requirement for graduation. They must attend live online classes with Sherrie for the girls and me for the boys each week. We have students from Burma, Singapore, Thailand, and Malaysia.

Pastor Conferences: Edifying the Saints-Teaching others Also



The Hebrews conference with Burmese pastors was a wonderful success. We were able to teach pastors who come from a number of doctrinal perspectives, engaging one Burmese Calvinist in a lively productive discussion. In September we will be repeating our popular course on "Support for the Bible "and "Religious Cults". We should get over 50 pastors attending. But the much-anticipated conference for this year will happen in November in Mae Sot on <u>Understanding the Book of Romans</u>. We expect a full house. I have spent this entire year writing a commentary on this profound book, especially on controversial disputed sections in Chapters 7, 8 and 9. The commentary will likely finish to be around 200-300 pages. Pray for this conference on Romans to edify the saints, clarify Bible doctrine and dispel the claims of myths and error in Burma, and empower them to better lead their churches.





Publications and MTB Radio

Publications: To the left is a delivery of our book The Deity of Christ: Declared, translated into Burmese. Also we are continuing to deliver Old Judson Bibles which we restored as well as thousands of our Gospel Booklets and tracts. The second picture is distributing Bibles to many who have never seen/owned one.

MTB Radio: For the 2nd quarter of 2025 we recorded over 1,503 unique listeners, listening for around 700 hours in over 66,000 individual sessions. Over 70 listeners stayed on for between 5 minutes and over 4 hours. The most popular track was our radio course on the Deity of Christ; a book I wrote. On the station

they get Bible, Gospel presentations, Godly Christian music, preaching and Bible study. Praise the Lord for the witness of Radio.
