I want to introduce you to a faithful servant of God, Pastor Fernando, a veteran missionary with over 22 years in the ministry. His life and family are a living testimony of commitment to God's work. Alongside his wife Jovaline, three of his four children serve as missionaries in different countries: in Ghana, his daughter Miroslava; in Italy, Fernando Jr; and in Mexico, his son Efraim while Pastor Fernando is in Panama, where he is passionately reaching souls and planting churches.

By God's grace, he has already established two churches, with little to no financial support, and he's now stepping out by faith to plant a third church on the outskirts of Panama City. His burden for the lost is matched by his action every Saturday, without fail, he goes out soul-winning, and the Lord is blessing his efforts with new converts.

Brother Fernando currently rents three locations for preaching and ministry, paying for them out of his own pocket. This is a heavy burden, yet he continues with joy, always saying: "No effort is too great for the Lord."

I'm praying the Lord would raise up 10 churches or individuals who would commit to \$25 per month, to help provide a modest \$250 in monthly support. This small amount will go a long way for him, allowing him to focus fully on soulwinning, discipleship, and church planting.

PANAMA

Dear Partners in the Gospel,

I bring you greetings from the beautiful country of Panama, a land of great spiritual need. Known around the world for the Panama Canal, this narrow strip of land in Central America connects two oceans and facilitates nearly 10% of global maritime trade, with over 14,000 ships passing through annually, carrying more than \$270 billion in cargo. Yet, while much of the world passes through Panama, there remains a deeper need within: the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Panama has a population of approximately 4.45 million people. While 85% identify as Catholic, only 9% claim Jesus Christ as their personal Savior. The fields are truly white to harvest, and there is still so much work to be done!

By God's grace, we currently have four faithful missionaries laboring in Panama. These men are on fire for the Lord and truly mission minded. Together, they have planted 12 churches and continue to reach the lost with zeal and perseverance. With your help, we were able to bring 300 Bibles to distribute to new believers and those recently baptized. We also provided 30 solar-powered audio Bibles, which are for those who cannot read but they can hear. These gifts are already bearing fruit!

A special thank-you to Brother Bonifacious, who generously donated study materials in Spanish to help local pastors grow in the knowledge of God's Word and train future leaders. Some of these pastors are working with great sacrifice, often paying for their meeting places out of their own pockets. In the attached letter, I will share their testimony specifically and how you can personally support these heroes of faith.

One of the greatest blessings of this trip was the **Missionary Training Conference**, which I had the honor of directing alongside Pastor Dan Breneman (Marion, NC) and Dr. Tom Knickerbocker (Florida). This was the highlight of the trip and a strategic investment into the future of the church in Panama.

We taught 9 sessions focused on The Great Commission:

- Missions and the Church
- Evangelism and Baptism
- Discipleship
- Establishing Local Churches
- Training Leaders
- Sending out Missionaries
- Supporting Missions
- Churches that Multiply
- And Reach Every Village unto the Uttermost!

Three men surrendered to full-time ministry during the conference. Praise God! This is the heart of our mission to train others who will continue the work long after we are gone.

Due to political unrest, road blockages, protests, and violence we had to end the conference one lesson early and leave the city sooner than expected. Despite these challenges, God protected us, and we were richly blessed to worship and fellowship with our brothers and sisters in Panama.
