Dear supporting churches and friends,


I apologize in delaying this prayer letter. I think I kept waiting until after Cameron's surgery to post a positive prayer letter and things keep getting kicked back. This letter will discuss a lot of medical situations with Cameron and Shannon.

Since my last update letter for Cameron's surgery, Cameron's surgery went well. The doctor was pleased with how it went, and surgically, his leg has healed well. Cameron has had a significant setback in his recovery. He is still not walking. He will potentially need months of occupational therapy to get back to where he was before surgery. Please pray that it would go faster than what is being projected.

Also, Shannon has had surgery since my last update. This was a surprise surgery to us. Shannon broke her leg in high school and had some hardware put into her ankle. This year it has started bothering her. She met with her doctor that performed the surgery over 10 years ago, and he decided that it was time to remove that hardware. She had a successful surgery last week and is recovering now. Please pray as she continues to recover and as I take care of the kids.

This year has come to an end with a lot more medical appointments than we were hoping for, but God is still good. Please pray for wisdom as we try to navigate recovery and travel and schooling over the next several months. Our hearts are heavy for Cameron and would love for him to bounce back faster than what the doctors are thinking. We covet your prayers. We do so much appreciate your support and prayers as you have allowed us to close out another year in Seedline.
