At the end of our 2nd service, he presented us with our new church birth certificate. We had over 60 people sign our charter that day. The Lord continues to add to the church every week. We have had 102 people saved in our first year. Praise the Lord!

Thank you all for praying for us on this special Sunday, and for those who have supported us financially throughout the year. I want to ask all our supporting churches and individuals to consider continuing their support for us for one more year. I believe we will be a self-supporting church by then.

We are still seeking and praying for the Lord to open the door to a different location, so that we can start Sunday School and Children's ministries, as well as a place to baptize our converts. Speaking of baptisms, we were able to use one of the local community pools last week. We baptized seven new converts. To God be the glory! Pictures are on the back of this letter.

We still need a piano player, help with livestreaming, and our music ministry. Please continue to pray about that. It would be a great opportunity for someone who desires to serve the Lord and see God's blessings in a new church.

I have an urgent prayer request for our son, Jack. He was involved in a terrible motorcycle accident on May 13th. He is still in the hospital as of this letter. He has had four surgeries so far. We are praying that it is all and that there are no infections. We are so thankful that the Lord spared his life on that day. It appears that he will make a complete recovery, but the road ahead will be a long one for all of us. We hope he will be able to come home after Memorial Day weekend; then he will begin rehabilitation. He has a broken wrist, and his leg/knee are in bad shape, and extensive road rash over most of his body. He will be out of work for months. Please pray for him!
