Dear Praying Friends,

Thank you for praying for Lifeline Baptist Church and for my family. I would like to offer a correction from last month's prayer letter. I stated that we had set a new average attendance record of 97 people per service. That was a typo, and it should have been 96. However, that typo became a reality this month as we set a new average attendance record for the second month in a row of 97 people.

I am pleased to report that we had 4 saved and 3 baptized this past month. The first person saved this month was a freshman at a nearby college named Annah. She started visiting with her boyfriend Logan, who joined the Army (more about him in a minute). After Logan went to basic training, Annah continued to come, and I was able to talk with her after one service and she accepted Christ as Savior. The second salvation this past month was one of the children in the church. We are very excited for him and his family! The third salvation was a young man I met in Boston at the Charlie Kirk vigil back on Sept. 18th. His name is Brenton. He started visiting Lifeline a few weeks ago and recently accepted Christ. Brenton was also baptized this past Sunday. The final person saved this month is a lady named Melissa, who is the niece of one of our new members. She grew up in church but had never been born again. Pray for Melissa to continue to mature in her relationship with the Lord. As for baptisms, on top of Brenton being baptized, Ron and Heidi, who were saved earlier in the year, were baptized this past month!

I do have some people that I would like for you to be praying for. We have a lot of visitors right now and I would very much like the opportunity to meet and talk with them about salvation. Pray for two young men who are friends of Brenton. He has been bringing them to church with him. Their names are Noah and Liam. Noah is Jewish and Liam has never been in a church before. They have been coming for several weeks. I am praying for their salvation. I also want to pray for one of our teens who comes to church by himself. Logan has brought 5 different friends to church in the past month. Please pray for Jesyiah and Jeniah. They are a dating couple that has raised their hand during the invitation that they are not saved, but I have not been able to meet with them yet. Pray that will happen. Also pray for Ashley, who has been coming off and on for a few months. She needs to be saved.

I would also like to ask for special prayer for Logan who went into the Army. He was medically discharged because of a pre-existing medical issue that he knew might be a problem. We had prayed about it before he went, and during basic training it became a problem, and he was discharged. Logan, since he was a young child, wanted to be in the military. He is sad but is transitioning well to being back and has a few different career options as an EMT or firefighter. Pray for him as he seeks God's plan for his life.

I trust everyone had a Great Thanksgiving, and I pray for your Christmas Services this coming month!
