Emmanuel and Julia used to be members but got out of church. A few years later they realized that was a mistake and they decided to come back with their three kids, and we are so happy to see them!

One of Manny and Julia's children is named Josiah. I am very happy to tell you that Josiah started attending LCA recently. This bumps our enrollment up to 17 students! Our year is going well, and we are praying that the Lord will work in the hearts of some of the young students and middle school students. Some of our kids that don't go to church or come minimally are lost and need to be saved. I am making a push for that, but as we all know we cannot make that happen. Will you please join me in prayer for the salvation of some of our LCA students.

This past month I was able to attend a church safety seminar. I most likely will be attending another one next month as well. We are taking steps to secure our church. We are looking at installing video cameras and establishing written safety procedures and doing training with our ushers and security team. I currently working with one of our members who is a Lt. in a local Sheriff's department on establishing the best procedures for our church. It grieves my spirit that we live in such an evil day that we must do these things. However, given the frequency of violence against churches I feel that it is critical for me to prepare our people for a hopefully, a day that never comes.

Lastly please be in prayer for the Chaplaincy at Rockingham County Sheriff's department. They are moving to a new building next month and I will have an office for the first time. This will be very helpful as I don't have a set place to be when I am in the office and tend to just float around. Having a set office will afford me some more opportunities with the Deputies and other personnel.
