When we finished our visit encouraging Ralph to continue growing in the Lord, we went back to sign out with the duty, and found out that Kimberly had led her to the Lord, Amen. God had impressed on Kimberly's heart to come out that night because He knew there was a young lady that was ready to get saved. We went to the next barracks to visit Noah and the duty was very interested in what we were doing. After finishing our visit, we went back to talk with the duty and about 2230 we were able to see David trust the Lord as his Saviour!

God has been blessing here in North Carolina and we thank you for your prayers and support. The kitchen renovation has been slow finishing but hopefully by end of year we will be able to share what God has done through you, our helpers in the ministry here.
