New England HELP Conference

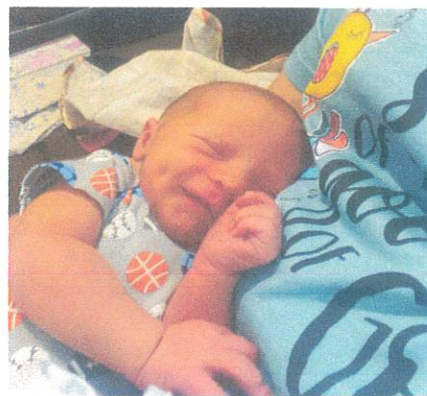
