While this addition was needed regardless, it may also open the door for us to welcome three to four more girls, pending approval from our county.

We've been busy this summer attending camps and jubilees, and the Lord has used these meetings in a mighty way to help and encourage the girls. We are also excited to share several special milestones:

- One of our young ladies graduated in May and will be attending Ambassador Baptist College this August
- A former resident who graduated in 2023 will be going to Commonwealth Baptist College this fall.
- Another young lady is currently entering her third year at Pensacola Christian College.
- At camp in June three young ladies surrendered their lives to the Lord.

The fruit of this ministry is continuing to grow, and we give God all the glory!

We currently have six girls on our waiting list, and although we are at full capacity, we are praying that the Lord will make a way for us to expand and reach even more young ladies with the hope and help that only Christ can give.

I want to thank each and every church, pastor, and individual who has stood behind us – not only supporting the girls' home but also encouraging and uplifting me personally. Your love, your financial gifts, your offerings toward the building project, helping with supplies, and your prayers are making an eternal difference. We could not do what we do without God's people – the best people in the world.
