RAISING SUPPORT FOR 'BUSH' CHURCH PLANTERS IN NEPAL!

During my trip to Nepal last March, I had the privilege of meeting church planters throughout the bush of Nepal. These men are poor with a passion for evangelism, discipleship and multiplying independent Baptist churches that will go do likewise. It was exciting to see the Lord call men throughout the 'bush' villages to the ministry with a passion for soul winning, pastoring, and church planting.

During the month of May, I took Stephen Thiumai of India to churches throughout the Northeast to present 8 national 'bush' church planters for prayer and support. Brother Stephen is overseeing these church planters. The support level is \$100 for 6 church planters and \$250 a month for 2 nationals who visit the church planters with instruction, counsel and encouragement. The response of the churches was a blessing. We praise the Lord for the support that was raised.

6 bicycles were purchased for 6 'Bush' church planters replacing their transportation by foot and enabling them to cover more villages. The cost was \$115 for each bike.







A new rugged motorbike was purchased by a church member for the 2 Nepal church planters to share in spreading the Gospel throughout the Himalayan mountains of Nepal. The cost was

\$2,500.



One more motorbike is needed so that each church planter could have their own bike.

When we packed and moved to Alabama in December 2019, I pinched a nerve that affected my lower back and left leg. After 5 years of pain medicine, physical therapy, shots, chiropractic adjustments and increasing pain, I scheduled back surgery and cleared my calendar from June through August for recovery.

My surgery was scheduled for June 5. In preop, my heart was in A-fib, and the surgery postponed until I could see a cardiologist in early July. However, my primary doctor was able to schedule me with a cardiologist 2 days after preop. I was cleared for surgery on June 10! Praise the Lord for God's calendar!

The surgery was a success with immediate relief for my leg and back. Praise the Lord for what He has enabled the doctors to do. My recovery is slow demanding patience. Every day is a better day! God's grace is sufficient!

Thank you for your concern and prayers during this time. By the grace of God, I plan to be back in the saddle this coming September to take the nationals to churches. I look forward to many more years of service in His kingdom.
