December brought to a close an amazing year in Utah. We had great services throughout the month, with a number of first-time visitors. Our annual Christmas program was on a much smaller scale this year, but went fantastic. Three of our men helped during our Bible study time on Sunday mornings and did outstanding. As we disciple and work with our little flock, our desire is to identify and develop their gifts and abilities in service to the Lord.

2025 opened the door for a brand new outreach in the Davis County Jail. There are 750 inmates in this facility, with five men's units and one women's. We have a team of ten who participate from our little flock and it has been an amazing experience. In addition to our weekly services, we began, in the spring, meeting with inmates who requested one-on-one meetings. This grew from two hours, to three, and now five hours each week. There have been nearly thirty saved throughout the year.

Opportunities continue with the chaplain work as well. It was a great year with the Farmington Police Department. In the spring, the city hired a new Police Chief and he is doing an outstanding job. My work as part of their Peer Support Team has opened the door to many CISD (Critical Incident Stress Debriefing) meetings with other departments in our city and county. This has allowed me to get to know many of the Fire and Law Enforcement personnel.

On the home front, it has been a fantastic and traumatic year. We have dealt with some major, life-changing decisions within the home, as well as seeing the faith and faithfulness of others strengthened. Please keep us in your thoughts and prayers as we seek to fulfill the call of God on our life here in Utah. God is good. He is worthy. He is able.
