It was a small camp for the youth of their church, but it was a big week of God working in hearts and lives. There was great liberty to preach each evening as well as during the morning devotion time. The kids responded to each challenge from God's Word and I pray made decisions that they will carry with them the rest of their lives. The following week, I traveled over to the camp hosted by Pastor Mallinak, at Camp Red Cliff, and preached for the Wednesday morning chapel service. They had a great group of kids who listened well as I brought a message of "Attributes of the Warhorse".

Please keep the chaplain and jail ministries in your prayers. God continues to bless both. My normal routine is to spend some or all of Tuesday at the police department. Some days are training or range days (firearms) and some are simply shift-change days where most of the guys are in the office during the day. This allows me to make contact with the majority of our staff each week. The jail ministry consists of Sunday afternoon service and then one-on-one meetings on Wednesday for two to three hours. We had souls saved in both the men's and women's units in June. God is good!

The church continues to grow little by little. Sometimes it is numerical. Sometimes it is spiritually. But God is doing a wonderful work at Calvary Baptist Church, in Farmington, Utah. An older couple who recently started attending found us online. They had moved from Colorado and were looking for a good Baptist church – in Utah that is not so easy. They faithfully attend each service and recently told me after a service, "Thank you and your family for obeying God and starting a church in Farmington. It is such a blessing to us." Amen. Sometimes, God sends us 'handfuls of purpose' (Ruth 2:16). Please keep our family and little flock in your prayers – we truly need every prayer!!
