

In October 2020 I was diagnosed with colon cancer. As I entered this season of my walk with God, I was/am fully trusting Him to do whatever He desires. Like most, I did not ask for cancer, but I understand God has a plan to bring Him glory through this. My job is to fully trust in Him wherever this journey leads.

After my diagnoses, I had surgery to remove the tumor in November



2020 and then started my chemo treatments the first of December. Near the end of December I had a few spots that were discovered in my liver cauterized. Then my January 2021 PET scan showed all the cancer was gone. Praise the LORD!! Hallelujah!!

As of today, I have completed eight rounds of chemo with four to go. I will complete my treatments the second week of May. I am doing well and so far my symptoms have been mild. I do get tired with each chemo treatment, but start feeling better after about five days.

During my off weeks of chemo I'm able to get out and see some of our area teams and coaches to share the Gospel and encourage them. However, I really look forward to when I can be with them more after chemo is finished.

I am amazed at God's faithfulness through all of this. I don't doubt it. It's just really cool to see it in your own life. God has used so many family, friends, and the church to minister to my family through this season. Calls, texts, food, cards, resources, prayers, visits, they have all been a huge blessing for us. We are truly humbled and thankful for each and every one of you who have joined our fight. Thank you for being faithful to God!

to engage, equip, and empower has not been stopped.


