

2024 Wayne Halbrooks Memorial Scholarship

Guidelines

The family of Wayne Halbrooks, announces the 2024 *Wayne Halbrooks Memorial Scholarship*. This scholarship, a minimum of \$250.00, will be awarded to at least one female athlete who is a senior attending a high school within the North and Northwest Alabama Fellowship of Christian Athletes areas.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- * Seeking graduating seniors with a record of volunteerism in the community in non-school sponsored activities and participation in extracurricular school activities.
- * Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0
- * Scholarship recipient will be announced *in April 2024 and funds released in August 2024 for the first semester* of the student's first year directly to the college and not to the student. It will be the student's responsibility to submit to the NWALFCA an invoice for first semester tuition and fees, student ID number and college information.
- * Applicants must have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor **and** a letter of recommendation from their High School Coach on their application attesting they are a qualified fit for this scholarship. Application deadline is <u>March</u> <u>29, 2024</u> by 4:00 p.m. to be received by the FCA. Late applications are not accepted.


