SAVE THE DATE CLERGY KIDS RETREAT 2026:

Sign-up: Registration, medical release and <u>full payment is due January 5</u> and is completely online this year. <u>Cancellation after January 5 will result in a \$25 fee.</u> One very important note is that full payment will be due at the time of registration. This really is meant to simplify the process and reduce confusion. All payments will be made online and no checks from individuals or churches will be accepted. If your church pays part of the fee then they will reimburse you directly rather than MVNU having to handle multiple checks. If your district offers any scholarships, those will automatically be reflected during the registration process.
