PASTOR'S REPORT

Dr. Sarmiento, Dr. Mahaffey, Members and Friends of the Assembly,

There is a quiet grace in watching God finish what He starts. After several seasons of transition, this has been a year of settling — of putting down roots and watching new life take hold among us. The promise of Philippians 1:6 has been on my heart often this year: the God who begins a good work is faithful to carry it through to completion. We have seen that faithfulness in tangible ways.

A few highlights from this year:

- **The Mount Carmel property has finally sold.** The Fairfax Church and Mount Carmel Church merged in 2023 but still had things to finalize, like selling the Mount Carmel property. After a long and patient wait, this chapter is closing, and we give God thanks for His provision and His timing. As of this writing, a few details still need to be worked out following the sale, and we ask for prayer as those matters are settled.
- **Our connect group continues to grow.** It has become one of the bright spots of our year — a place where our people go deeper in God's Word, carry one another's burdens, and build the kind of friendships that hold a church together between Sundays. We are grateful to see new faces and growing hearts around the table.

Reflecting on the past year, I praise God for what He is doing through Be Hope Church. We don't measure success by attendance but, rather, we truly celebrate transformed lives. As a church, we pursue the hopeless and fight for 5,000 lives to be transformed through baptism by 2030. Since June 2025, we have witnessed 270 baptisms.

Our average attendance grew to 2,204 people, representing 15.5% growth over last year. This evidence of people becoming someone who pursues the hopeless by encountering God, owning their faith, and finding community. Jesus. Every chair filled represents a story of healing, restoration, and new beginnings.

God is moving in the next generation in extraordinary ways. Each week, approximately 235 students gather, engaging, growing in faith, and learning to become leaders. In Be Hope Kids, 419 children are experiencing the love of Jesus in environments designed just for them. We believe we are not simply raising kids and students, but we are developing future generations to continue building the Kingdom and pursuing the hopeless.

Our vision has always extended beyond the walls of our church. Through Hope Beyond Bars, we continue bringing the hope of Jesus into places where darkness has often seemed overwhelming. This year alone, 462 salvations were celebrated through this ministry. One hundred forty-one individuals discovered that no prison cell, no past mistake, and no circumstance is greater than the redeeming power of Jesus Christ.

As God continues to move, we recognize that growth creates both opportunity and responsibility. To date, our people have embraced our value of live generously as they've given/pledged toward future expansion that will create environments for Be Hope Kids to grow. Redesigned gathering spaces will help families connect and build community. And additional seating will create room for countless people who have not yet walked through our doors, but whose stories God is already writing.

We believe this is only the beginning. Together, we will continue pursuing the hopeless. Together, we will continue fighting for 5,000 lives transformed.

I'm pleased to give my first report as pastor of Monroe Nazarene. Since arriving in September, our family has been welcomed with open arms into both this church and this district. It has been a joy to get to know so many of you and to hear your hearts for Christ and His Church. Monroe is a growing community with tremendous potential and a deep hunger for a movement of God. In just the past few months, we have already seen new families begin attending our church, and we are excited about the days ahead.

One of the greatest strengths of our church is our emphasis on missions. Over the past two years, we have given more than \$100,000 to missions, primarily supporting our partner churches in La Fe, Cuba, and Kiseke, Tanzania. In addition to our commitment to missions, we have continued to serve as a source of provision within our community through our food pantry ministry. On average, the food pantry provides food assistance to 30 families each week. It has also strengthened its partnership with the local school district, creating new opportunities for us to serve and support the children and families of Monroe.

One area of focus for our church is becoming more accessible to those who do not yet know Jesus. We believe that following Jesus should be an easy decision, and we want to remove as many obstacles as possible for people to encounter Him. We began by receiving a Christmas Offering to help improve our "front door"—the areas that create a first impression for guests, including our online stream quality, sound quality, and lobby environment. Through the generosity of our congregation, we received just under \$32,000 and are currently in the process of implementing these improvements.

We have also recently launched an Alpha ministry designed to create a safe space for skeptics and seekers to ask questions and explore faith. Meeting at a third-party location, Garver's Family Farm Market, our first session welcomed five participants into the eight-week course.

As you can see, through the incredible generosity of this church, a renewed focus on reaching people, and the tremendous potential of our community, we believe some of our best days are still ahead. We are expectantly trusting God to do something extraordinary through this church and are faithfully preparing for the harvest yet to come.

The Lord moved in mighty ways this year at Target Dayton! We preached the gospel and provided free hot meals to thousands of poor and homeless people in six services a week with full bus transportation. Hundreds made decisions for Christ.

On Christmas Day, nearly 4,000 men, women and children attended our Christmas service at the Dayton Convention Center. Over 400 volunteers prepared meals, greeted guests, and distributed gifts. We had our first ever service for families with kids and almost 600 attended. Every person who attended received a Christmas gift as they left, including a lunch, gift cards, and gospel materials.

Nearly 1,200 people in need received a brand-new winter coat during the month of November. And in April, we put brand new (name brand shoes) on the feet of 1,000 people. These ministries of compassion drew large crowds to our services to hear the gospel, and many responded to Christ.

In July, we held our first ever Festival Latino to reach the growing Hispanic community in Dayton and saw over 8 different nationalities represented. At the end of August, we held our first Summer Crusade at the Levitt Pavilion in the heart of Dayton that over 1,400 people attended with 4 hours of music and preaching, free grilled hot dogs, free sub sandwich meals, free school supplies, Gospel materials, bouncy houses, and free ice cream. We also prayed for hundreds of people and baptized over 40 on site that day!

Cindi and I deeply appreciate the prayers and support of so many who volunteer and give to make this life changing ministry possible for the poor and homeless men, women, and children in Dayton. God bless you for giving to feed and save the poor!

Our community life revolves around taking steps of obedience to his call to **kneel** in prayer and worship every day, corporately and individually; to build relational **bridges** of discipleship with each other and with our community; and to **go** into the world in selfless service and faithful witness, expecting nothing in return.

We served our community at Target Dayton, West Carrollton Schools, and we cooperated with West Carrollton City in their Fall Festival, Holiday Festival, Easter Eggstravaganza, and pool events. We supported Oasis House, Good Samaritan Homes, MUM Food Pantry, Hope Rising Women's Center, and Elizabeth's New Life Center, and BOGG Ministries with our giving and our volunteers serving, in addition to our regular missions giving. We went to the Dominican Republic with a Work & Witness construction team, continuing our work on the Villa Caoba Church building, which we started in 2023. We also worked with our city leaders to repair homes and maintain properties in West Carrollton for folks who found themselves unable to do these projects on their own. We continued to serve the needy in our community with a free bicycle ministry.

PARENT AFFILIATED CONGREGATIONS (PAC)

Allow us to better explain what Parent Affiliated Congregations are in the Church of the Nazarene. Provided for you is a list of PAC Churches that currently exist on the Southwestern Ohio District.

WHAT IS A PAC?

A PAC is a ministry (organic church, multi-site, multi-congregational, new work, NewStart, etc.) that is reported as affiliated with a parent church. A PAC has a leader or pastor who is responsible for pastoral care of the group and is connected with a parent church.

WHY PAC?

We want to recognize and celebrate what we want to reproduce! The PAC designation was created to address the needs of churches beginning creative new congregations, who had no way of reporting those new works. Ethnic congregations, organic churches, and multi-sites are notable examples. If these affiliated congregations are not registered, they do not receive literature, are not identified via official channels, and do not appear in any database and thus are "off the grid" and unidentifiable for collaborative efforts, networking, and mutual encouragement.

WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN A PAC AND A CHURCH TYPE MISSION (CTM)?

CTMs are any not-yet-organized churches which may or may not have a parent church. In contrast, PACs are affiliated with a parent church and may be classified as a not-yet-organized church or an organized church.

IF A PAC IS NOT A SEPARATE ENTITY, WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN A PAC AND A SMALL GROUP?

A small group which is started to reach new people could become a PAC. PACs normally have a leader, are evangelistic, and function as distinct congregation. Final definitions are left to the discretion of the parent church and PAC leader.

HOW ARE PAC STATISTICS REPORTED?

All PACs are assigned a unique church number. A PAC will appear in the District Journals and within computerized data systems at the Global Ministry Center indented beneath the parent church. This solves a reporting (and identification) problem for congregations-within-churches. A PAC has the option of including some or all of its statistical data with the Parent Church's data. Both the Parent Church and PAC will fill out the Annual Pastor's Report, but there is great flexibility in how the statistics are divvied up, since in all reports they will appear together.

WHAT ABOUT "FUNDING THE MISSION?"

PACs are not a new method of increasing giving. Congregations registered as PACs contribute to "Funding the Mission" based on reported income, just like all other CTMs. Whether the parent congregation reports the income or the PAC reports the income is entirely between the parent church and the PAC. Whichever one reports the income would contribute to "Funding the Mission."

WHEN WILL THIS BE IMPLEMENTED?

The PAC designation was approved by the Board of General Superintendents in May 2011 and is available for immediate use when registering a new congregation.
