We seek to walk with God as our guide and try to draw those with whom we come into the Church. We are men who try to spread Christ's Kingdom here on earth. We can never forget that Prayer is the foundation from which our service grows.

- ❖ Commit to a daily Rule of Life; fulfilling the vows of Prayer, Study, and Service.
- ❖ It has been said that in Prayer, we communicate with God; in Study, we learn about God; and in Service, we become God's servants on this earth – his eyes, ears, hands, feet, and voice – to do His will.
- ❖ Undertake a personal program of evangelism through prayer and service, working to bring others to Christ through His church.
- ❖ Pay national, provincial, assembly, and chapter dues promptly.
- ❖ Participate in the offerings to the funds to BStA.
- ❖ Attend and participate in Diocesan and Provincial Assemblies and cooperate with other church groups whenever possible.
- ❖ Bring other men to know Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.
- ❖ Meet regularly under the Rector's authority.
- ❖ Visit the sick, elderly, and shut-in.
- ❖ Conduct Bible studies.
- ❖ Call on newcomers and visitors, encouraging them to take an active part in the Church.
- ❖ Organize and train parish members in one-on-one evangelism.
- ❖ Minister in homes for the mentally retarded and mentally ill, nursing homes and jails.
