Dear Parent(s)*

Following our recent survey regarding wraparound care provision, we received 30 responses. Of these, only 8 families-out of a possible 318 (2.5%)-expressed a need for continued wraparound care.

In light of this limited demand, we have made the decision to **discontinue our wraparound care service**, effective from **1st September 2025**.

We understand that this may affect a small number of families, and we want to assure you that this decision was made carefully, based on the data collected and the long-term sustainability of the service.

Despite this change, we are pleased to confirm that we will **continue to offer**:

- **Breakfast Club** – Monday to Friday, 8:00 – 8:40am – *FREE*
- **Extra-Curricular Clubs** – Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday, 3:10 – 4:00pm – *FREE*
