As part of our topic on the Victorians, we are visiting Armley Mills in Leeds on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> December where the children will have a day living history experience.

The class will experience two workshops, the Victorian schoolroom and the 'mill children'. These workshops will help pupils to gain an understanding of how school and industry were linked.

The Victorian schoolroom provides a first-hand experience to explore objects and offers a chance to use items such as slate boards, dip pens. Children will gain an understanding of the key features of a Victorian classroom and be able to compare the similarities and differences between school now and in the past.

This is a roleplay workshop and as such it adds to the experience if the children are in costume. If possible, it would be great if children could come dressed in clothes similar to Victorian attire. Examples that work well and fit with the period would be caps, white aprons and dresses/skirts for girls, shirts, waistcoats and flat caps for boys.

Children will need a packed lunch. If your child is in receipt of free school meals, a packed lunch will be provided. We will be travelling to Armley Mills at **9am** by minibus and plan to be back to school at **3.10pm**.
