Dear Parent(s)*,

We are writing to remind you of our school jewellery policy and to ask for your continued support in helping us keep all children safe during the school day.

For health and safety reasons, jewellery is not permitted in school. Small stud earrings may be worn.

What is not safe to wear in school:

- Hoop earrings
- Drop or dangling earrings
- Rings
- Bracelets or bangles
- Necklaces or chains
- Any other jewellery items

Staff will be reminding children of this expectation and supporting them to follow the policy consistently. We kindly ask that any jewellery (other than stud earrings) are removed before children come to school each day.
