



Father David Sunberg, was born February 7, 1964 in Cincinnati to now the late Harry and Eunice Sunberg. Father is the youngest of four children. He has three older sisters.

Father received his Sacraments of Initiation and primary education at St. Cecilia in Oakley. The family moved to Anderson Township and Father finished eighth grade at Immaculate Heart of Mary parish. He went to McNicholas High School, graduating in 1982. He entered the Pontifical

College Josephinum in Columbus, Ohio in that same year. Father received his Bachelors in Religious Studies and a minor in Philosophy in 1987. He entered Mt. St. Mary Seminary where he did his graduate work. He did his internship in Coldwater, Ohio in 1989. He was ordained a priest on June 6, 1992.

His first assignment was to St. William Parish in Price Hill. In 1996 Father was commissioned a First Lieutenant as a chaplain for the U.S. Army. He was stationed in Germany and did peace keeping in Macedonia during the Bosnian conflict. He returned to the Archdiocese in June of 1999 and was made pastor at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Church in Milford. In 2005 he was assigned as pastor to Our Lady of Lourdes in Western Hills. In 2016, Archbishop made him spiritual director at Mt. St. Mary Seminary. In 2018 he was made Director of Formation for the Permanent Diaconate. In 2023, he was made Director of Priestly Formation.

Father is a member of the Knights and Dames of the Holy Sepulcher and is Prior (chaplain) to the Cincinnati- Dayton Section.

Father is a Fourth-Degree member of the Knights of Columbus.

He is a member of The Catholic War Veterans and The Veterans of Foreign Wars.
