



GENERAL PRICE LIST

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing in the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected. Stateline Cremations is not a funeral home, but it is a cremation service provider. We **do not** offer embalming.

Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff\$390.00

This fee is for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving the remains.) This fee includes the following:

- Personnel available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to respond to the initial call Arrangement Conference.
- Coordinating service plans with crematory, and/or other parties involved in the final disposition of the deceased.
- Clerical assistance in the completion of various forms and permits associated with cremation.
- Also covers overhead, including facility maintenance, equipment, insurance, administration expenses, and governmental compliance.

Basic Direct Cremation Offering\$1150.00

This charge includes transfer of the remains to our facility, necessary services of staff, care of body, local transportation to the crematory, and cremation service charge of \$300.00, and the coroner's permit to cremate from Illinois. This charge does not include visitation, rites or ceremonies prior to, or after cremation of the remains or certified copies of the death certificate. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. This container that encases the body is made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). This container is included in the price of direct cremation.

Upgraded Direct Cremation Offering\$1325.00

This charge includes the basic direction and writing an obituary with the family and publishing it on our website. We can also submit the obituary to the newspaper. The additional cost of a newspaper obituary would be paid by the family.

Premium Direct Cremation Offering\$1540.00

This charge includes both basic direct cremation and upgraded direct cremation. The additional cost of a newspaper obituary would be paid by the family. This charge further includes a register book and remembrance cards for a memorial service. Tax on merchandise would be paid by the family.

This list does not include the prices for certain items you may request us to purchase on your behalf, such as flowers or newspaper notices. The costs for these items will appear on your bill or the statement detailing the goods and services you have selected.
