There is no guarantee the odd/even numbering of the wards will be in any way consistent from the old to new map, so the 14 old-odds will be effectively serving at-large for the 2023-25 period.

Also, there is no guarantee that current even# alders will still be in an even# ward in '23, so some of them may be out of luck to run until '25.

Likewise, if any of the odd# alders serving a 21-25 term find themselves in an even# ward in 25, they can't run again until '27.
