## Furniture

**Tables:** 12"-15" high - child-size 20x36" (approximate size) no longer than 4'

Chairs: 9-11" seat leveal - stackable chairs preferred.

- **Area rugs:** 6'x9' or 8'x10' in medium, calm colors, no cartoon-like characters
- **Work rugs/mats:** Approximately 18"x 30", need to roll up.
