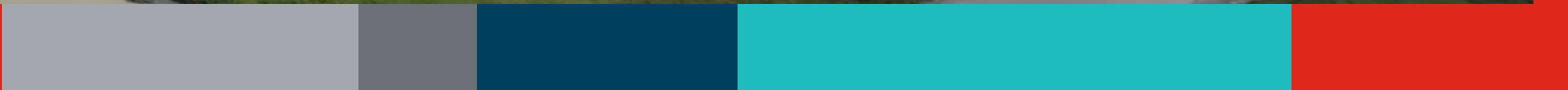

Today, Chartair is part of a larger group of aviation companies including the country's leading aeromedical company, AirMed, based in Sydney and Dubbo-based Air Link.

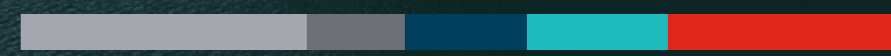
Our clients have taken us far and wide, and into some of the remotest areas of Australia. Along our way, we have met truly inspirational people, shared stories, made memories and saved lives.

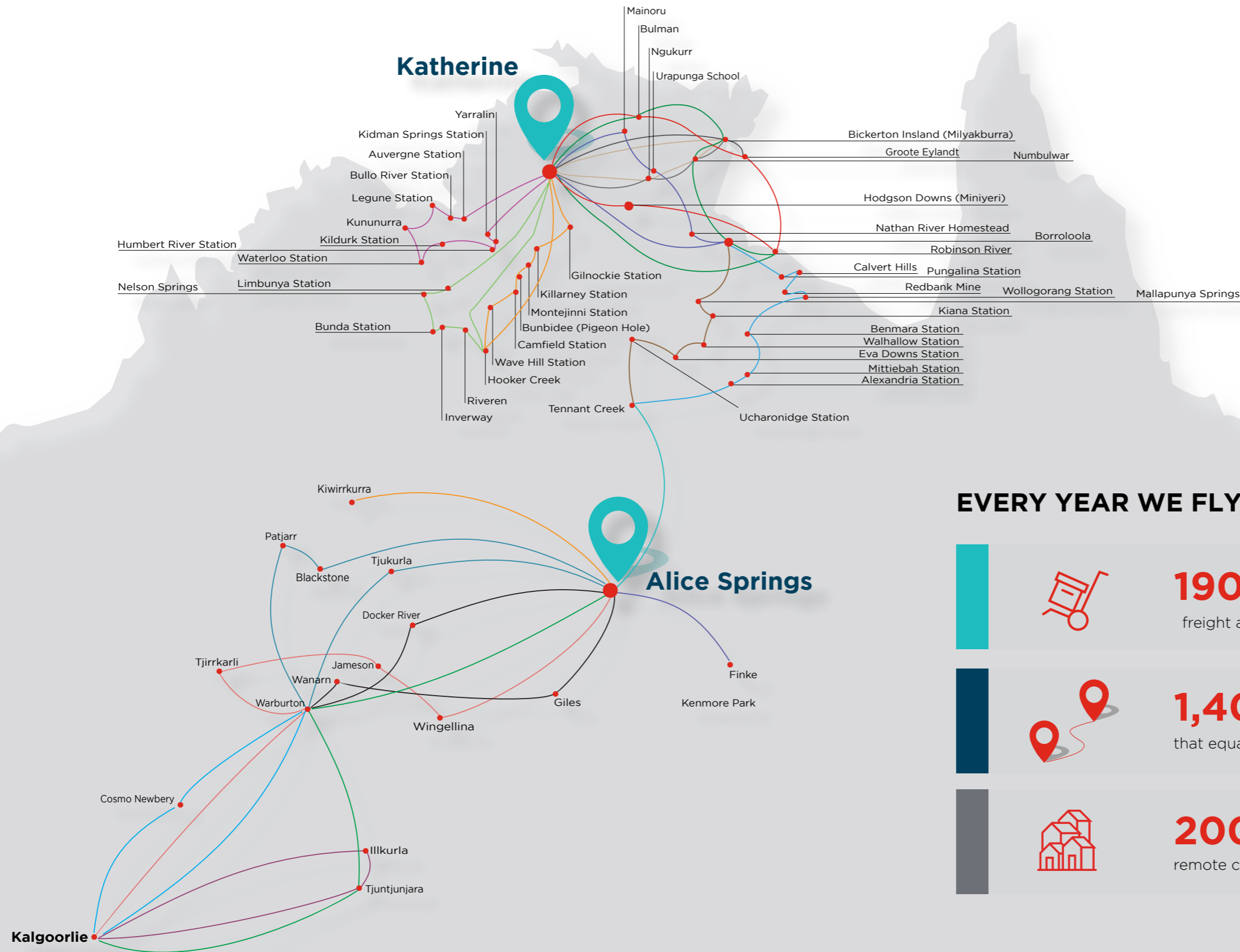

Chartair operates a number of scheduled passenger and freight services on behalf of the Federal Government Remote Air Services Subsidy (RASS) Scheme throughout the Northern Territory, Western Australia and South Australia. These services operate as an essential

lifeline transporting passengers, freight and medical supplies to remote Indigenous communities and isolated outback stations and homesteads.

Yirara College Alice Springs

Each June we were delighted to host a visit by 20 or so students and teachers from Yirara College to our facility in Alice Springs. With this project we hope to sow the seed of interest in the aviation industry as a potential career path for them when they complete their school studies.

Apprenticeship and Cert. II Program

In conjunction with Aviation Australia, Chartair supports a Northern Territory Government initiative to provide maintenance training for Year 11 students in Darwin and Alice Springs. The support includes providing access to hangars, classrooms, and three de-commissioned aircraft. Chartair have subsequently employed two graduates of the first course as apprentice engineers within our maintenance organisation.



Remote Laundries

Initiated in 2018, the concept involves a 20-foot container tailored to hold four washing machines and four dryers, plus a sink, that can easily be moved from community to community as required. Chartair sponsored the Remote Laundries project during the 2019 Barunga Festival.

University Pirates Rugby Union

Chartair are committed to supporting local and national sports and teams. We provided uniform sponsorship to the University Pirates Rugby Union team.

Aboriginal Investment Group - Mobility Project

Wheelchairs are an absolute necessity in health centres throughout the NT. However, Aboriginal communities are often not well set up for wheelchair access, making it even harder for users to get around. The Aboriginal Investment Group Board established The Mobility Project to source more robust wheelchairs that can perform in rougher conditions.

So far, AIG has distributed more than 100 wheelchairs throughout the Top End and recently Chartair helped them deliver chairs to Groote Eylandt, Bulman and Borroloola.



Anglicare NT Secret Santa

Since 2020, Chartair has supported Anglicare NT's Christmas Party Secret Santa projects to deliver gift packs to the aged care facilities in Nhulunbuy - East Arnhem Land.



School Holiday Program Deewin Kirim And Peppimenarti Community

Chartair, together with Foodbank supported the Maningrida Community Health Centre Dental Clinic "Big Smiles Day" initiative by transporting toothpaste and brushes from Darwin.



Mums On Bikes Project

ABC News Darwin shared a beautiful story about the Mums On Bikes group and its goal to provide bikes, including buggies, to Mums with young children on Galiwin'ku - the largest community on Elcho Island, 550 km north-east of Darwin in the Northern Territory. The group had 40 bikes and trailers donated and was looking for donations to help get them to Elcho. Chartair came across this post and organised two flights to Elcho to deliver items for the group at no cost. The mums and kids were so excited to receive the bikes and buggies early so that more children could enjoy the experience of riding with their mums.

1974

Leach Aero Services established in Alice Springs providing fixed-wing flight services and aircraft maintenance

1988

Took over operations in Alice Springs and Darwin of Chartair. Changed name to Chartair

2013

Chartair became the first General Aviation in the Northern Territory to receive Part 145 Maintenance approvals. Two more Cessna Conquests added to the fleet

2006

Purchased Aboriginal Air's Darwin facilities to become the new head office for Chartair

2015

Chartair changed ownership. New owners also purchase aircraft owned by Overall Aircraft Maintenance, taking fleet to more than 40 aircraft. This is in addition to their existing Sydney-based operations of AirMed

2017

Two Cessna Grand Caravans, previously leased, now purchased to take C208 fleet to four. New Cairns base established upon successful award of RASS contract to provide mail and freight services to Cape York in Far North Queensland

2018

Increased RPT services from Darwin. Introduced a suite of new scenic and tourism products

2021

Three more Cessna Conquests added to the fleet for a total of six - one of the biggest operators of this aircraft type in the Southern Hemisphere

2020

Successfully navigated the challenges of COVID-19. Maintained most services and kept all staff employed. Support from Federal and the NT Governments was greatly appreciated

2022

Successfully become a Basic Aviation Risk Standard (BARS) Registered Aircraft Operator.
