

## **Event and Club Activity Definitions**

Scottish Canoe Association and British Canoeing provide insurance cover for members, clubs and events, subject to some specific definitions. The cost of providing this insurance cover is met through the income received from membership, club affiliation and event membership fees.

It is important for all involved to understand the scope and limitations of this insurance cover and, in particular, the eligibility criteria to ensure we do not have events, activities or people that are 'uninsured' that people believe are covered.

The information below outlines the minimum requirements in order for people and activities to be covered by the insurance policy and membership benefits. Some events may have additional eligibility in place (e.g. ranking competitions, qualifications etc).

Note 1: Data should be retained for 1 year, unless there has been an incident in which case it should be retained for 3 years after the point at which all those named in the incident report have reached the age of 18

Note 3: Recognised systems include the Canoe Slalom and Racing entry systems linked to the 4 Nations Membership check function.

Note 2: In addition to membership criteria above, most competitions have further restrictions to Full / Junior members only. Check event entry / discipline competition criteria for further details. On the Water / Full members of British Canoeing England, Canoe Wales or Canoe Association of Northern Ireland also benefit from a reciprocal eligibility for competitions.
