



**Concorde Fire Alpharetta
Alpharetta Ambush Soccer Club
Financial Aid Policy
2026-2027**

The Concorde Fire Alpharetta / Alpharetta Ambush Soccer Club (AASC) will make available financial aid funds to those individuals in need to reduce the economic barriers to playing soccer in the Alpharetta, GA area. As such, if funds are available, AASC will make financial aid awards available to deserving players and their families. No one will be disqualified from consideration based on sex, race, color, creed, or religious beliefs.

Applicant must request and complete the financial aid application from AASC and return the form confidentially to Doug Yearwood, President at doug@concordefirealpharetta.com. The application can also be mailed to:

The financial aid application must be submitted before or soon after being offered a roster spot on a Concorde Fire Alpharetta team. (Typically, this will be within 4 or 5 days from the last day of tryouts.) Returning players should make every effort to apply during tryouts. Deadlines will always be extended if there are delays created by the club.

Supporting financial documentation is REQUIRED for consideration.

Please email, mail, or deliver to Doug Yearwood and all information will be kept private and confidential. The required documentation includes:

1. Certified current 2025 Year Tax Return for all household adults, **front page ONLY showing Adjusted Gross Income** with social security numbers marked out/erased.... OR....
2. Two consecutive current pay stubs with Year-to-Date information included.

Note: School lunch certificates and letters are no longer accepted as proof of financial need.

ONE OF THESE TWO DOCUMENTS MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH APPLICATION OR IT WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED FOR FINANCIAL AID.

AASC utilize the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Poverty Guidelines and Tables to determine financial need consistent with City of Alpharetta Recreation Parks and Cultural Services policies. The AASC Board of Directors review and determine financial aid awards. Once a decision is made, Doug Yearwood will notify the applicant by email.

Financial Aid Award

If financial aid from AASC is granted, the financial aid award will reduce the annual fees normally due. If granted the full award, the annual fee will be \$550 for the soccer year (Fall and Spring). For U8 Jr. Academy the annual fee will be \$250. If the annual adjusted gross income is greater than the threshold to qualify, partial awards can also be granted on a sliding scale greater than \$550.

Other Fees

Mandatory fees for uniform kit, tournaments, winter training, fall charity drive, summer league and travel expenses will be the responsibility of the family and not included in the Financial Aid Award.

When are Fees Due?

Once AASC has notified the family the Financial Aid award has been granted, the \$550 annual fee will be due as follows:

Option 1: Pay \$550 (or approved amount) in full when registering in June.

Option 2: A four-payment plan with \$125 due in June at registration, \$150 due on Aug 1, \$150 due on Sep 15, and \$125 due on Nov 1. U8 Jr. Academy schedule is \$100 due in June at registration, \$100 due on Sep 1, and \$100 due on Nov 15. If the award amount is more than \$550, the 4 payments will be adjusted proportionately.

Late Payments: Late payments will make the player immediately ineligible to participate in practices or games until the account is paid and current. If payment is going to be late, contact Doug Yearwood before the due date and discuss options at doug@concordefirealpharetta.com

Other General Guidelines for All Financial Aid Requests

If the player requests a transfer and leaves the AASC for any other soccer club during the seasonal year, AASC requires payment of all financial aid amounts and all team fees not yet received as of the date of the release request and before the player release will be approved. No exceptions.

Under no circumstances will player passes be generated and approval to practice or play games be granted for financial aid applicants prior to approval and execution of the financial aid application, receipt of supporting financial documentation, and financial obligation fulfilled.

Financial aid will be granted on a full soccer year (Fall and Spring season) basis by the Ambush Board and determined on a case-by-case basis.

Recipients of financial aid will be required to volunteer time and skills to Ambush to help offset the financial impact of such financial aid.

Applicants must re-apply annually.

Privacy and confidentiality should be maintained. Contact will be limited to the President of AASC and the Board of Directors.
