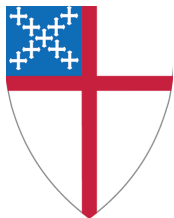
Pre-chorus. Your name is the highest. Your name is the greatest. Your name stands above them all. All thrones and dominions, all powers and positions; Your name stands above them all.
