Jesus tells of a landowner whose generosity scandalized the workers who arrived first; the last receive the same wage as the first, because the kingdom of heaven operates on grace rather than merit.

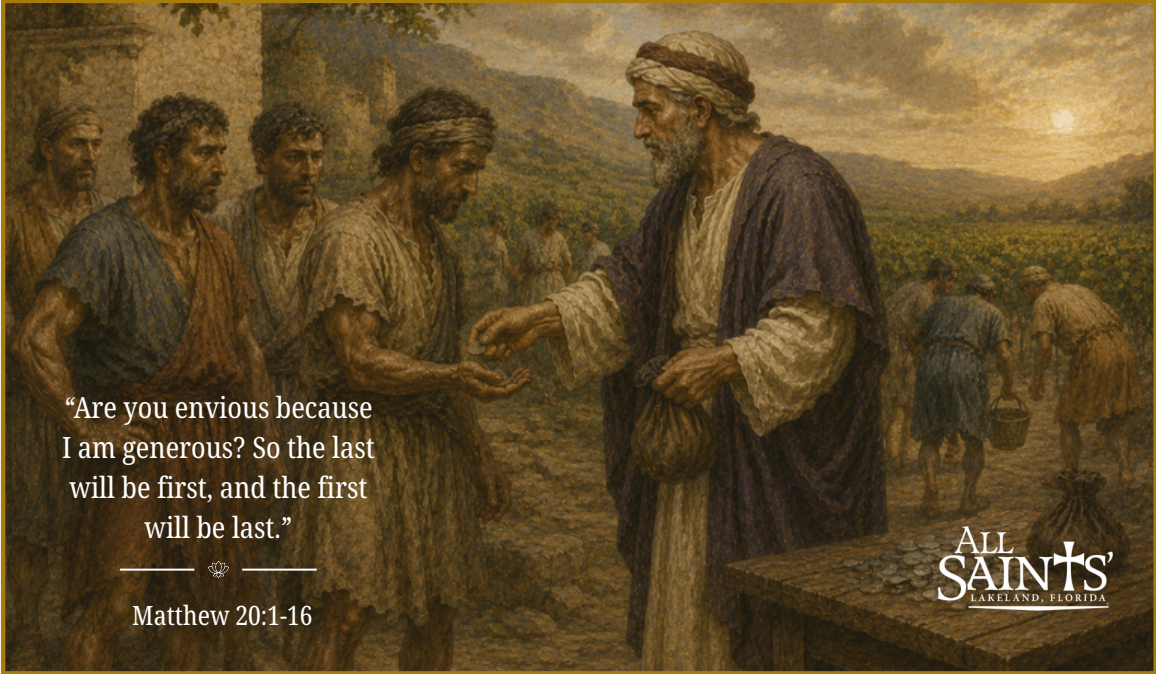

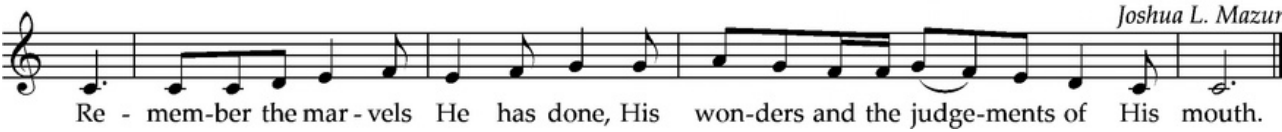
