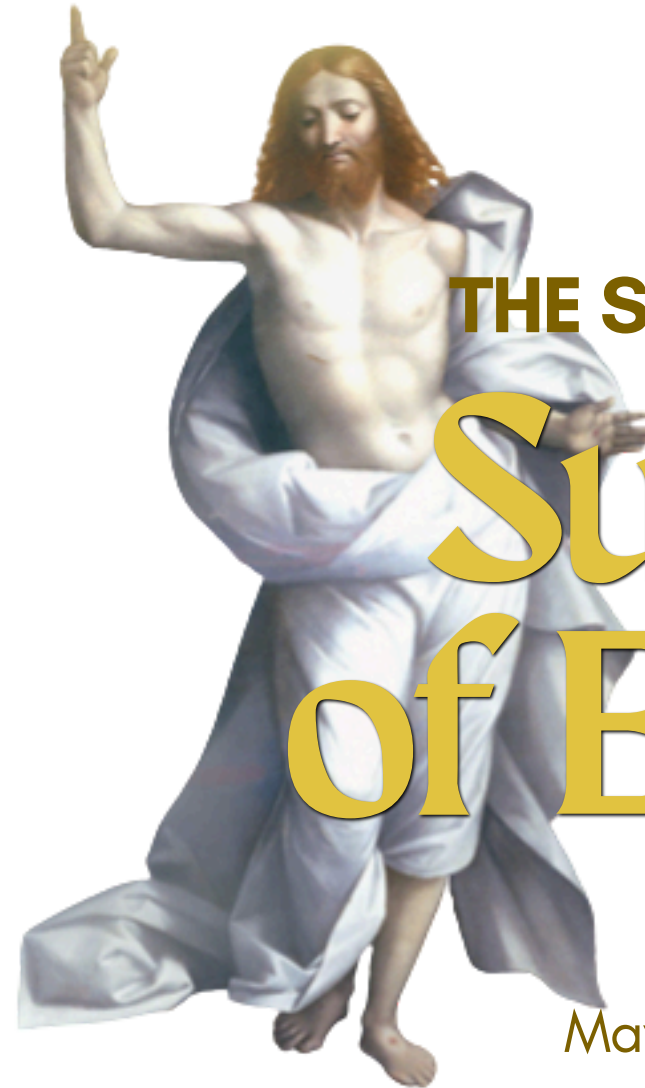

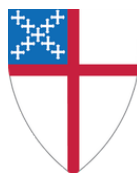
## **ABOUT THE COVER**
