

ABOUT THE COVER

The Third Sunday after Pentecost, recognized as **Proper 6 (Year A)** in many liturgical traditions, falls on **June 14, 2026**. The thematic focus of this day centers on the commissioning of the disciples, the initiation of mission, and the compassionate response of Jesus to a world in need.

Primary Themes

- **The Compassion of Jesus:** Jesus is moved with compassion for the crowds, who are described as "harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd" (Matthew 9:36).
- **Receiving and Giving Freely:** The central message of this day is the imperative of mission, summarized by Jesus' instruction: "Freely you have received; freely give" (Matthew 10:8).

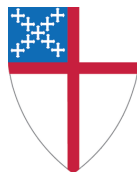

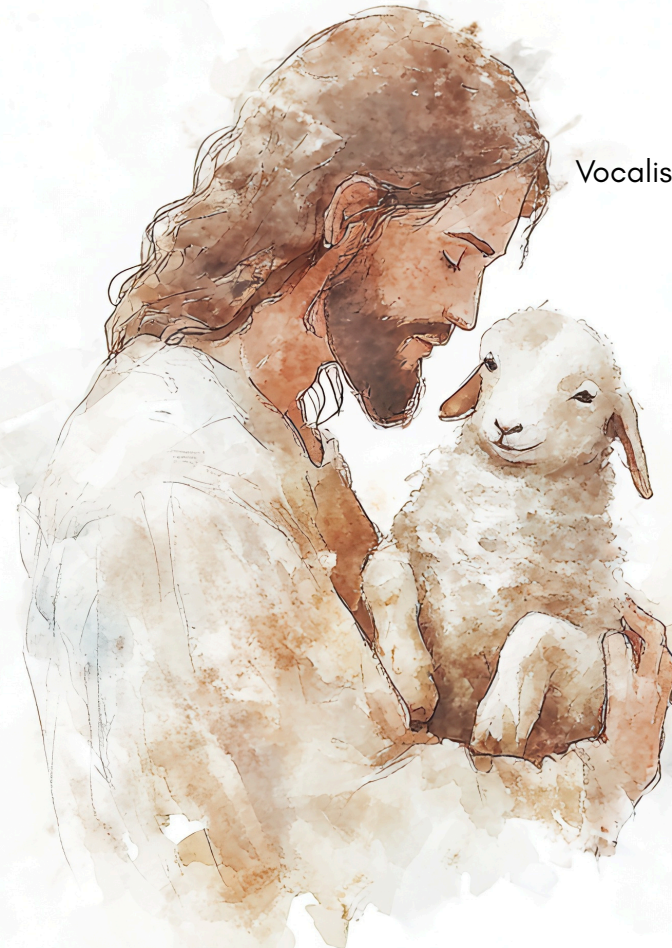
