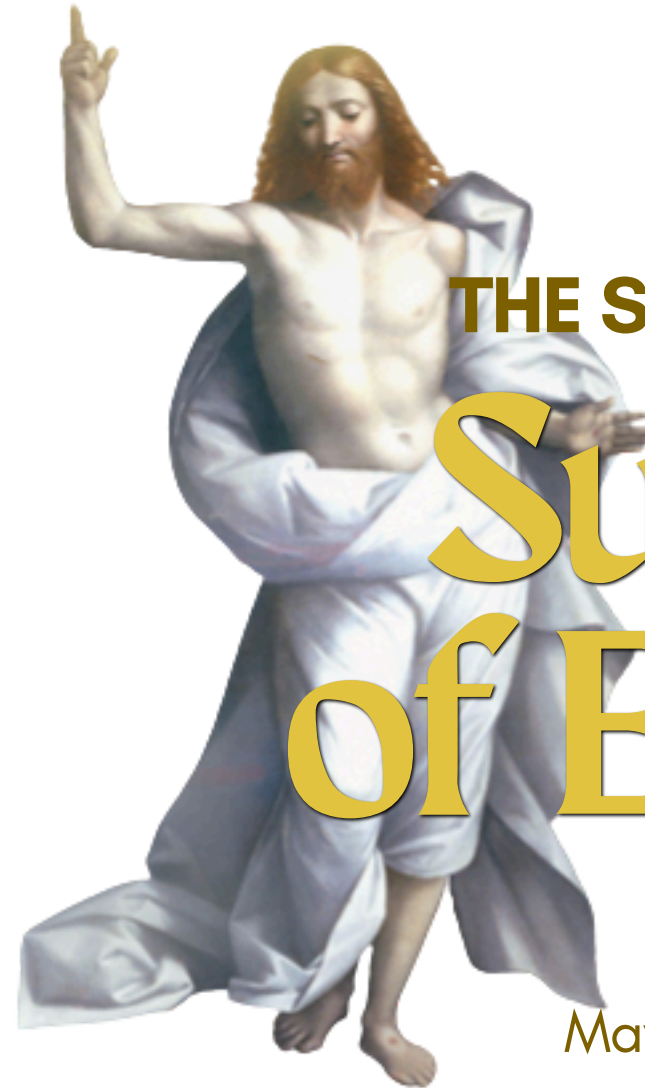

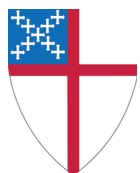
ABOUT THE COVER
