

## ABOUT THE COVER

The Second Sunday after Pentecost focuses on themes of faithful response to God's call, trusting in divine promises, and the evidence of the power of Jesus in his earthly ministry.

- Calling and Trust (Genesis 12:1-9): The story of God calling Abram to leave his home for a new land, highlighting faith in God's promise, covenant, and the directive to "be a blessing".
- Justification by Faith (Romans 4:13-25): Focuses on Abraham as a model of unwavering faith, trusting that God was able to do what he had promised.
- The Power of Faith (Matthew 9:9-13, 18-26): Jesus calls Matthew, a tax collector, to follow him and demonstrates his authority to heal a woman with an issue of blood and raise a young girl from the dead.

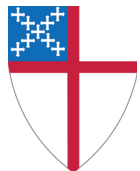

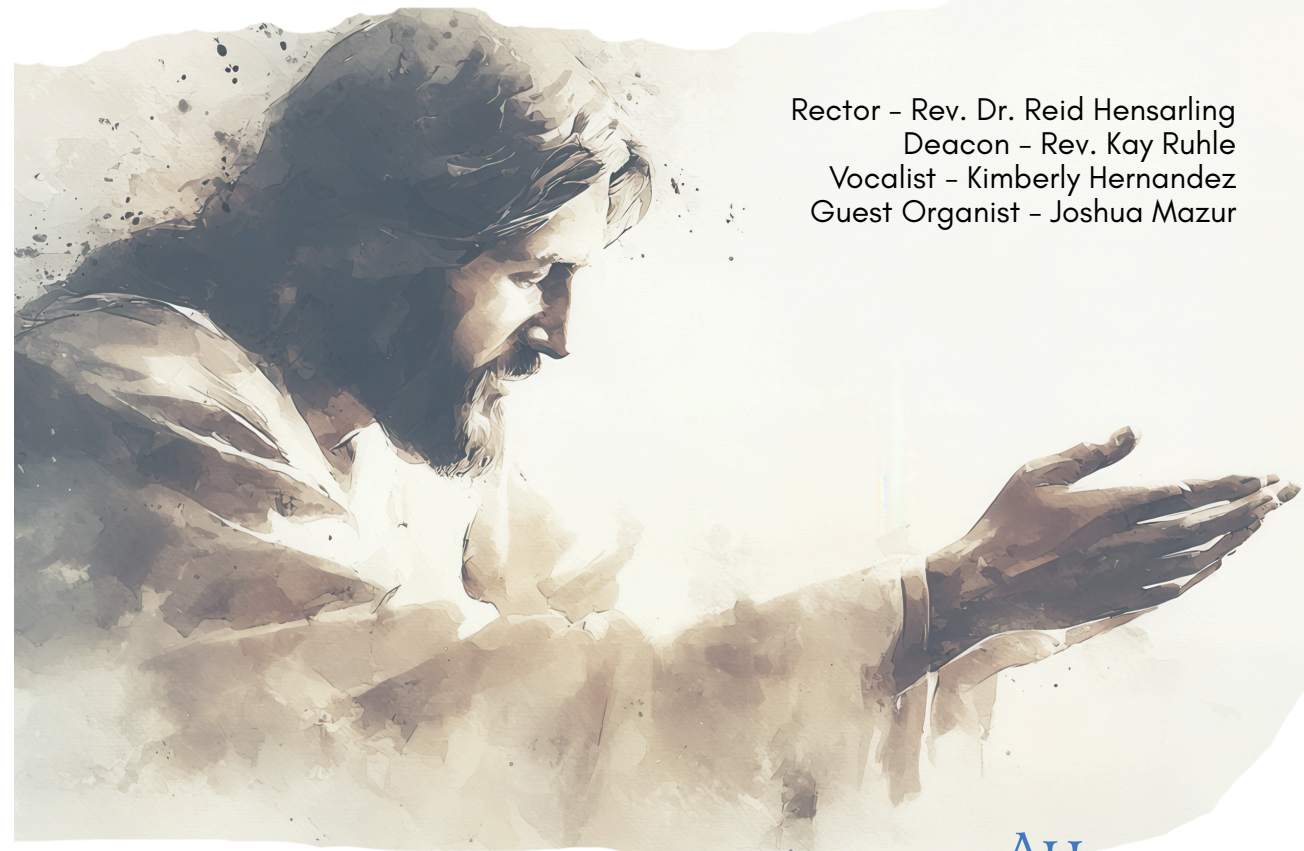
