



EDUCATION

Lamar County is committed to fostering educational excellence at every level-from early learning to higher education. With strong public schools, respected private institutions, and access to college and technical training, our community values lifelong learning and student success.

Lamar County School System

The Lamar County School System serves students from Pre-K through 12th grade across four campuses:

- Lamar County Primary School (Grades PK-2)
- Lamar County Elementary School (Grades 3-5)
- Lamar County Middle School (Grades 6-8)
- Lamar County High School (Grades 9-12)

The district focuses on academic achievement, student growth, and career readiness through programs like Advanced Placement, fine arts, athletics, and technical education pathways.

Private Schools

- St. George's Episcopal School - A college-preparatory school grounded in Christian values.
- Rock Springs Christian Academy - A Christ-centered environment for Pre-K through high school.



Higher Education

- Gordon State College - Offers associate and bachelor's degrees in business, education, nursing, humanities, and STEM.
- Southern Crescent Technical College (SCTC) - Provides hands-on career training and adult education programs.
- UGA Griffin Campus - Offers undergraduate and graduate programs in agribusiness, microbiology, education, and research.

Public Libraries

Lamar County is part of the Flint River Regional Library System and Georgia's PINES network.
