

Fee-For-Service Updates

Effective May 1, 2025, we are updating our prices! Please note the following changes:

In-Town: \$15 flat fee, up to 2 hours.

Out-of-Town: \$3 + \$0.55/km, up to 2 hours.

Double-Fare: Appointments lasting beyond 2 hours will incur a double fare.

Every additional stop will incur \$1 which is paid to the driver.

Clients who require the accessible van (wheelchairs, scooters, walkers) will see a \$10 flat fee to use the staff operated van.

Reminder

We require 3 full business days to book a ride.

Late cancellations within 1 full business day of a ride will face a 100% fee.


