Application Deadline: August 19, 2026

Applications must be received by GSFA by the deadline. A drawing will be held at the 2026 Georgia Fire Service Conference scheduled for August 24-29, 2026 in Augusta, Georgia from those individuals that submit qualified applications meeting all scholarship eligibility requirements. GSFA will award up to six grants in the amount of \$500 each.

Scholarship Criteria:

1. The applicant must be enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited undergraduate college or technical school for the upcoming 2026 fall term.
2. The applicant must be an active member of the Georgia State Firefighters Association (GSFA). A GSFA member's spouse, child or dependent is eligible.
3. The following items must be on file at the GSFA Office by the required deadline:
 - Completed application
 - Verification of enrollment in a college or technical school.

It is the responsibility of the applicant to complete all questions on the supplied form. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered. The total application will be regarded as confidential. Applications and supporting documents must be properly filled out and returned to the GSFA office by August 19, 2026.
