

# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

October 5, 2025 | Twenty Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

"When the days for Jesus' being taken up were fulfilled, he resolutely determined to journey to Jerusalem." (Luke 9:51, 56)

Like a skilled strategist, Jesus avoids minor confrontations to focus on the decisive battle.

We hear this saying very often, "chase two rabbits, catch none." This good saying emphasizes that attempting to pursue too many things simultaneously may result in not achieving any of them successfully. We can't just spread ourselves too thin. Thus, like a great strategist, Jesus was journeying towards Jerusalem, he quietly passed through a Samaritan village that rejected him, but this decision was made by James and John. Despite years with Jesus, they've yet to grasp his core lessons of humility and mercy, wishing to summon fire from heaven to punish the inhospitable town. Jesus gently rebukes them, then proceeds to another village, clearly indicating that his destination and purpose lie in Jerusalem, where he'll embrace suffering on the cross as the Messiah.

We, too, can be tempted to react harshly like James and John when confronted with unresponsiveness. Or we, too, can easily make the decision for God by focusing on what we want to do, losing the main focus on allowing others to encounter Christ, grow spiritually, and save souls. By reflecting on Jesus' core message today, we can foster a patient and empathetic heart, becoming effective witnesses to God's redeeming love.


