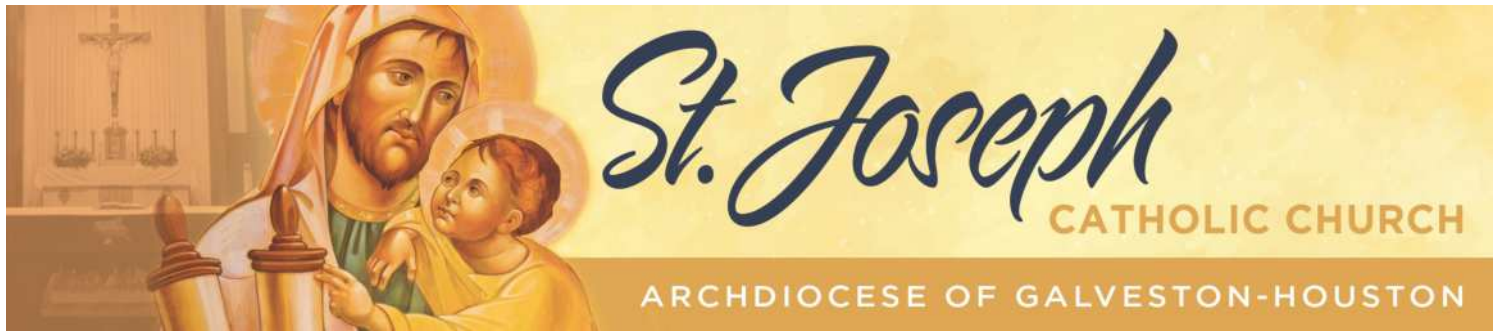

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

November 2, 2025 | The Commemoration of all the Faithful Departed

"You will grieve, but your grief will turn to joy. A woman giving birth to a child has pain because her time has come; but when her baby is born, she forgets the anguish because of her joy that a child is born into the world." (John 16:20)

The joy of the world and the joy of God are vastly different. Worldly joy is the deception of sin, while the joy of God is true love. Worldly joy is fleeting, but pain lasts forever. On the other hand, the joy of God is profound and enduring.

Dear parishioners of St. Joseph,

All Souls' Day reminds us of our shared human destiny, reminds us of the promise of eternal life in God's loving embrace, and our call to remember and pray for our deceased loved ones and all souls, knowing that death is not the end. Our prayers for the departed unite us in love, faith, and compassion, and remind us that our eternal salvation rests in the merciful hands of our merciful God. The altar that we have built in the FLC is for the display of your loved ones; you can drop off a copy of their photos to our office.

Going back to this scriptural passage for further reflection, Jesus invites all of the disciples, including us, to learn to experience the joy of the Lord, even amidst grief, knowing that *"your grief will turn to joy."* *The joy of the Lord comes from the manifestation of the Father's holy will (Lk 10,21), the repentance of sinners (Lk 15,9), and the return of God's children, "who were dead but are alive again, who were lost but have been found" (Lk 15,32). To attain this joy, Jesus was willing to sacrifice Himself to atone for our sins. If we desire the joy of the Lord, we better be prepared to offer our own sacrifices for the salvation of others.*

The invitation for us today is doing something good for someone else so that we will encounter the joy that Lord promises when doing it because of love for Jesus, and then we are to share our profound experiences of joy when we had the opportunity to serve others.
