



FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

November 23, 2025 Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

"By your perseverance, you will secure your lives" (Luke 21:5-19)

Dear Parishioners of St. Joseph Church,

We are heading toward the end of the liturgical year, reflecting together on the end times with Jesus's encouragement to hold firm in our faith, to persevere through the trials and struggles of our lives, and to keep our eyes fixed on Christ as we continue to work for our own salvation and the salvation of all. Jesus also presents us with a great challenge as we journey toward these end times, saying "They will seize and persecute you; they will hand you over to the synagogues and to prisons, or they will have you led before kings and governors without you being prepared what to say. And they will put you to death. You will be hated by all because of my name."

As I reflected with you in my homily last week over the discipleship of Christ Jesus, we recognize that: Being a disciple of Christ Jesus implies that we must make hard choices a lot of times during our lifetime. We will not always get what we want a lot of times. We may find ourselves at odds with others who do not share the same values with us. We may realize that: It's not easy -It's not easy to do what needs to be done, to say what needs to be said, to work things out when it bothers us to compromise. It's not easy to wait, to be out of control, to be without power, to allow another, even God, to have the final word on certain matters. It is not easy to forgive those who wrong us, and those whom we disagree a lot of times, and to look beyond those differences and focus our eyes on Christ. It's not easy to even endure a certain illness and let go of our loved ones as we leave this world to return to God.

In the past two weeks, we have said our goodbye to two of St. Joseph Church' heroes, Mr. Jim Giror and Dr. Hughes. They have been faithful parishioners of our St. Joseph Church since 1948 and 1960. They both have greatly contributed to our parish and have inspired many souls in the city of Baytown of how they live their lives. While we are grieving and praying for the repose of their souls that the Lord, in his love and mercy, will surely welcome them to the kingdom of heaven, we continue to reflect on how we ought to live our life and what we ought to do to glorify God and build up his kingdom here on earth by our zeal and effort of preaching the Gospel and allow others to encounter God through our words and actions. St. Paul reminds us that we don't just live and die without any meaning when he said, "Eye has not seen, and ear has not heard, what God has prepared for those who love him." (1 Cor. 2:9)
