


Impostor priest email/texting scams

Recently, there has been an increase in reports of fraudulent email solicitations for financial support, usually in the form of gift cards. These reports are coming from email accounts or text messages identifying as Archdiocesan priests. To minimize fraudulent impact, pastors are encouraged to remind their membership that priests/churches would never make such appeals to the parish community. Advise parishioners to notify the church office immediately if they receive any unfamiliar donation requests.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Merry Christmas and Happy New Year to you!

Dear parishioners of St. Joseph,

May the abundant grace of God be upon you and all your family members; and may your Christmas days be full of love and laughter: "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life." (John 3:16)

Christmas is truly a season of sharing - sharing our love with God and with one another. St. James reminds us, "Never detach the gifts from the giver; every good gift and every perfect gift is from above" (James 1:17). Therefore, the value of a gift does not depend so much on its material worth, but on the spirit of "The Giver", advent is the season for sending cards and giving Christmas gifts. We send greeting cards to our loved ones and friends, but we also send social cards to those we may have met only once or twice.

Is there a card or a gift for those we don't know, for those we pass by without a second glance, for beggars on the streets, for the homeless, for those shivering from the cold or suffering from loneliness?

The most meaningful gifts are those that come from a heart filled with love and compassion.

Let's ask a deeper question - What does the heart full of God's love look like? To answer this question, we take a look at our Blessed Virgin Mary as we journey toward the Solemnity of our Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God on January 01, 2025, which is the Holy Day of Obligation. "When I heard your greeting, the baby in my womb leaped for joy." (Luke 1:44) Mary carried Jesus, the word of God, in her heart, and she brought this greatest gift to her relative, Elizabeth, which filled her heart with joy, and even John the Baptist in her womb leapt for joy. Thus, God is the source of joy. Some joys are deeply personal, but when shared, that joy can spread to others. In fact, it's very hard to hide joy in our heart; sorrow can be hidden, but joy by its very nature is meant to be shared. The mystery of the Annunciation and the Christmas that we are about to celebrate carries this special meaning. How can we have God and how can God become our joy? We ought to learn from Mary: listen, obey, and act according to God's will. We are invited to reflect deeply on the mystery of Christmas that reveals to us about who God is, what God wants to tell us, and then reflect on what we must do to make this mystery more real in our lives.
