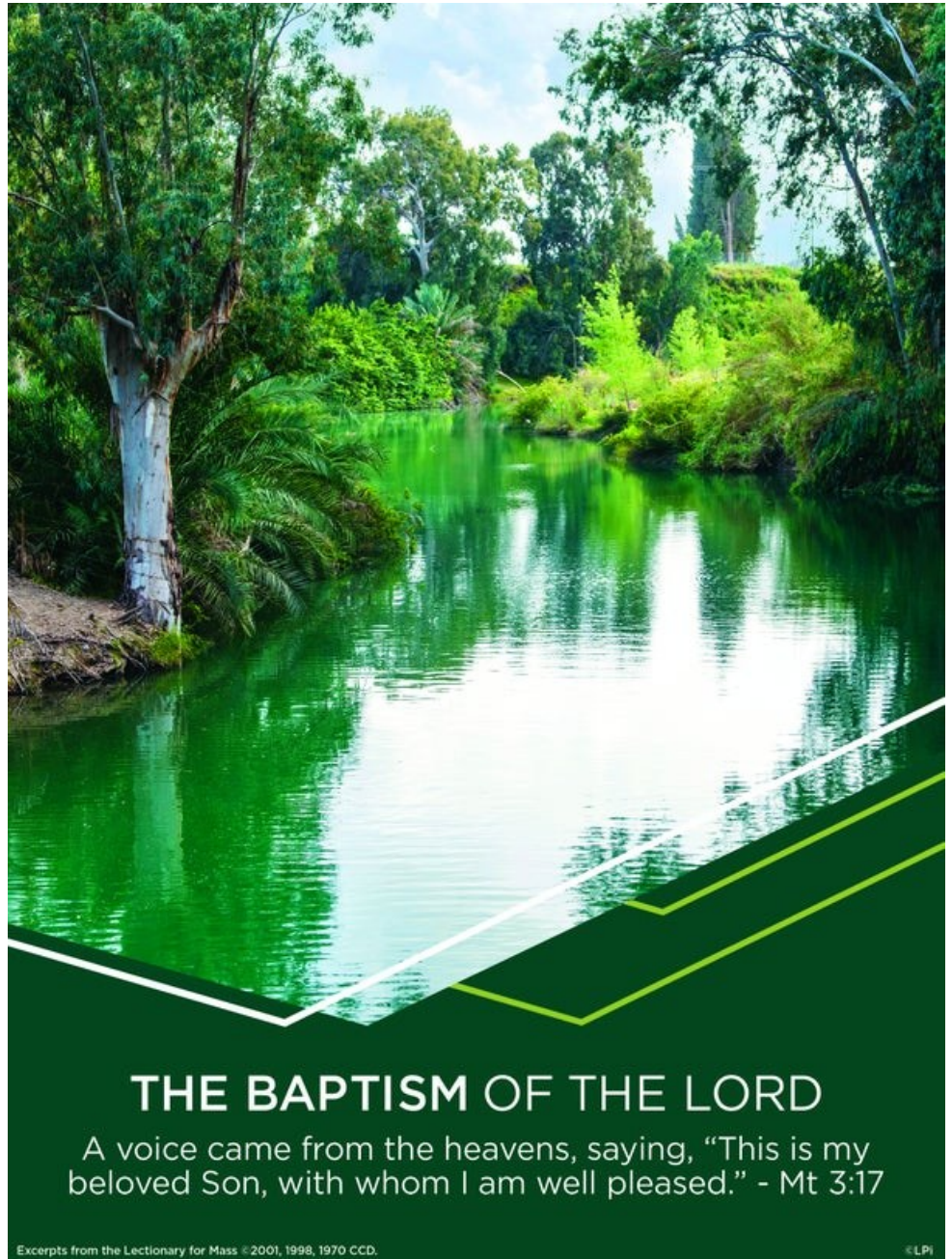

Recently, there has been an increase in reports of fraudulent email solicitations for financial support, usually in the form of gift cards. These reports are coming from email accounts or text messages identifying as Archdiocesan priests. To minimize fraudulent impact, pastors are encouraged to remind their membership that priests/churches would never make such appeals to the parish community. Advise parishioners to notify the church office immediately if they receive any unfamiliar donation requests.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

January 11, 2026 | The Baptism of the Lord

Dear parishioners of St. Joseph Church,

We are journeying toward the Baptism of our Lord Jesus after The Solemnity of Epiphany. It's important then for us to ask the question of why we baptize infants. The Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church states, *"The Church baptizes infants because they are born with original sin; they need to be freed from the power of the Evil One and brought into that realm of freedom which belongs to the children of God."* (no. 258) so, when parents have their children baptized, they deepen their commitment to protect and nurture the infant. Through baptism, we are cleansed from original sin and become part of the Body of Christ, the Church. Salvation is a gift from Almighty God in which Baptism is the gateway to our salvation and opens ourselves up to receive other sacraments. We can never "earn" the gift which is freely given. However, we are called to respond to the gift through the lives we live.

A common concern is whether parents must attend Mass regularly to have their baby baptized in the Church or not. I would like to answer it as follows: An important question for us to ask ourselves is, why aren't we attending Mass? Is it because of work schedules? Illness of ourselves or someone we love? Is it indifference or negligence? If we are not attending Mass and not living our faith, the question surfaces: Why do we want to have our child baptized? Yes! We have a right to have our child baptized, whether or not we attend Mass regularly according to canon 843. However, the minister of baptism (bishop, priest or deacon) has the responsibility to ensure that parents and sponsors are properly prepared and that there exists a well-founded hope that the child will be baptized and raised Catholic. Though a priest cannot deny your child baptism, he can delay the baptism until he is certain that there is a well-founded hope that the child will be raised Catholic. I encourage you to speak with your pastor so that he can help you come back to church. Even though you may not attend Mass regularly that does not mean you cannot come home.

On this day of celebrating The Baptism of our Lord Jesus, may we come to know of God's love for us, desiring to bring us back to Him and the Church. Amen!

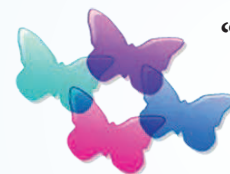
