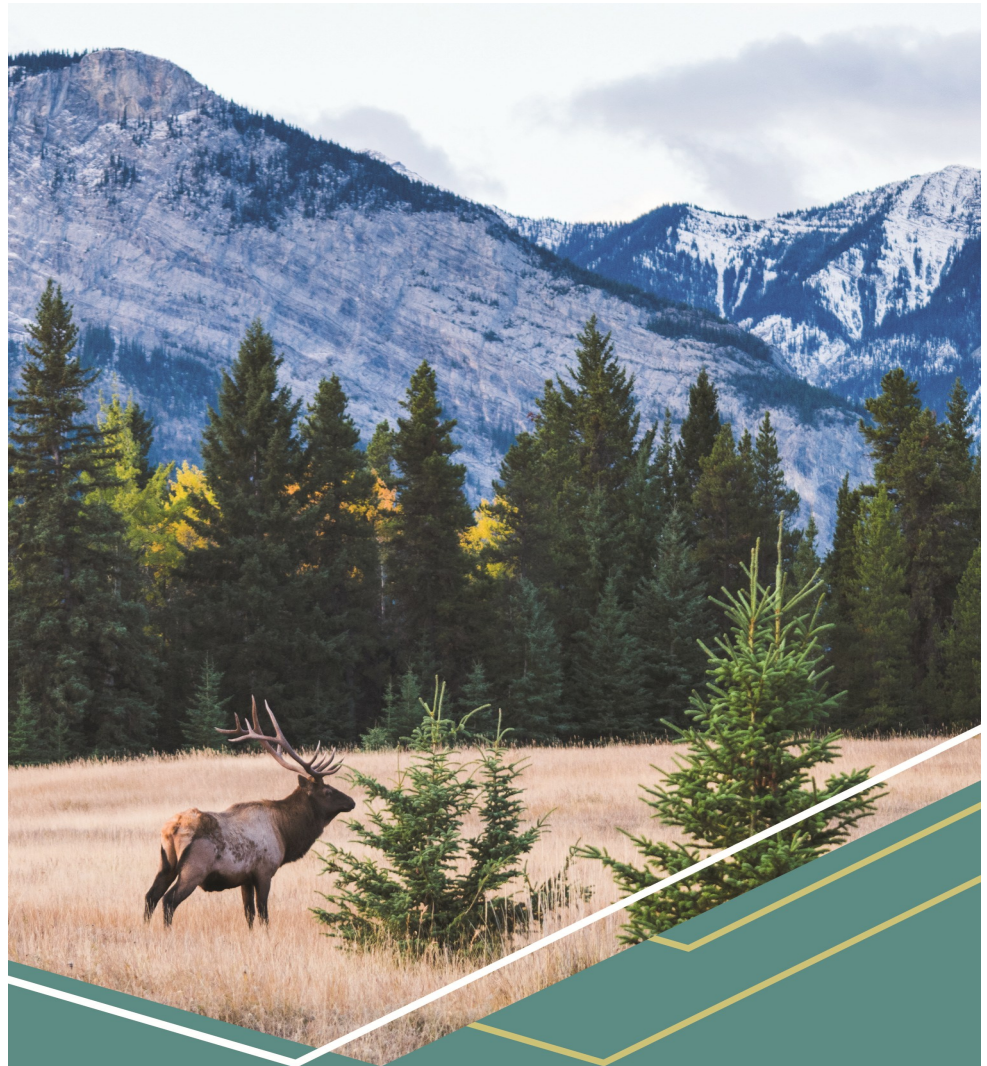

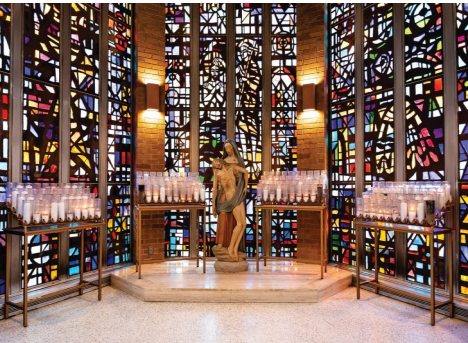

That our faith grows and we generously share out of love and not out of obligation. "For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven." Matthew 5:20 The Pharisees lived according to the letter of the law, and they used this to elevate themselves above the other people. Jesus is clear – it's the love that you have in your heart, for God and others, that will get you to heaven. Simply following church rules to the letter and not out of love, does not necessarily put you on the path to heaven. Attending Sunday Mass and then gossiping about a fellow parishioner on the parking lot is an example of being a modern-day Pharisee.

Texas Education Freedom Accounts (TEFA)

Choose Catholic Schools Starting in the 2026 school year, Texas will launch a brand-new Texas Education Freedom Accounts (TEFA) program with up to \$1 billion in funding to help families cover educational expenses for students in PreK through 12th grade. Parishioners who have wanted to send their children to Catholic school but were concerned about costs can now do so with tuition funded by the State of Texas. Texas has approved school choice, and the deadline to receive \$10,000+ per child begins February 4. Inform your parishioners now. Parents must apply during the February 4 - March 17 application period. Sign up to receive information on applying at www.choosecatholicschools.org/TEFA.

Scam Alert

A new scam has come to light targeting residents across the United States with text messages that pretend to be from toll road operators. For many who receive these messages, it's an easy and expensive trap to fall into. The scam begins when people receive a message claiming they have unpaid tolls and may be charged fines. Scammers then ask for card details and a one-time password sent via SMS to steal their money. Additionally, there are artificial intelligence (AI) generated scams to be on the lookout for.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

February 15, 2026 | Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

“Whoever touched Him was healed” (Mk 6:56)

In every age, if there were someone capable of healing every illness, people would surely flock to that person, because everyone longs for healing. The crowds sought every possible way to touch Jesus, hoping to be healed. It was the touch of faith that brought about healing. The touch of faith led people to Jesus, and then it was He who touched their hearts.

Dear parishioners of St. Joseph,

We too need to touch the Lord so that He may touch each of us. The storms of life can make us feel weary, discouraged, and exhausted, but do not lose heart. Touch the Lord, receive Him in our heart through the Eucharist so that He may touch us and lift each of us up. In this way, we are able to journey faithfully to the end of our lives. And also with this invitation to attend Mass and receive Jesus into our heart, I would like to re-post last week one-minute of Catechesis for us to reflect deeper on the heart of the Mass:

There is the one time at Mass when heaven falls completely silent - No hymn. No movement. No instruction. Just silence. It is the holy silence of arrival. This moment is when the priest has spoken the words of Jesus: “This is My Body.” “This is My Blood.” Something impossible has just happened: Bread is no longer bread. Wine is no longer wine. It is Jesus Christ who is now truly present, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity.

This moment is sacred because it is the time, not to say more, but rather the time to believe more. The silence says what words cannot: “God is here.” The Church teaches that at this moment: Angels adore. Heaven leans toward the altar. Christ stands among His people as the Lamb once slain. In Scripture, whenever God appears, people fall silent. So does the Mass.

The real question is what we should do at this silent moment: Do not rush to private prayers. Do not look around. Do not try to fill the moment. But just whisper in your heart: “My Lord and my God.” That is enough. Because after the Consecration, silence is the loudest confession of faith the Church makes. So, the stillness after the Consecration is not a pause in the Mass. It is the heart of the Mass. Amen!

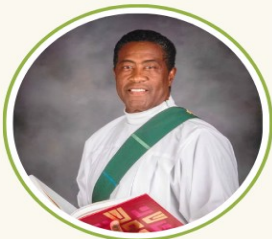
