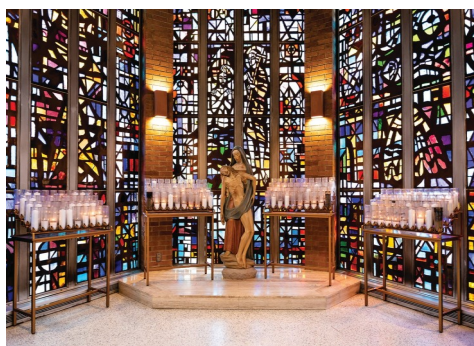

Advise parishioners to notify the church office immediately if they receive any unfamiliar donation requests.

This second time Spring Crawfish Festival was more than just a fun event — it was a beautiful reminder of what we can accomplish together as one **faith-filled family**.

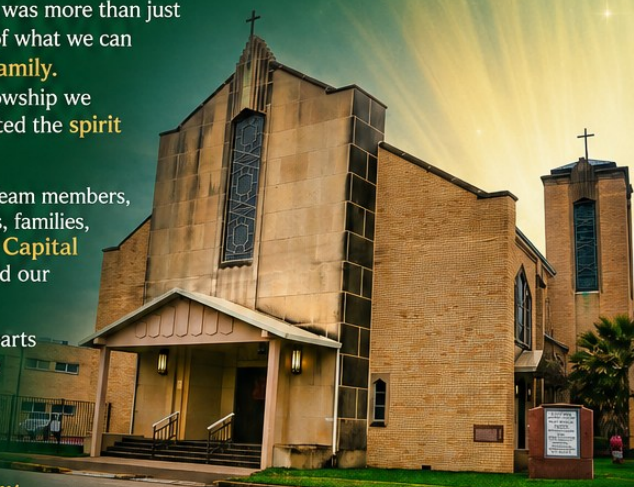
