Impostor priest email/texting scams

Recently, there has been an increase in reports of fraudulent email solicitations for financial support, usually in the form of gift cards. These reports are coming from email accounts or text messages identifying as Archdiocesan priests. To minimize fraudulent impact, pastors are encouraged to remind their membership that priests/churches would never make such appeals to the parish community. Advise parishioners to notify the church office immediately if they receive any unfamiliar donation requests.

Scam Alert

A new scam has come to light targeting residents across the United States with text messages that pretend to be from toll road operators. For many who receive these messages, it's an easy and expensive trap to fall into. The scam begins when people receive a message claiming they have unpaid tolls and may be charged fines. Scammers then ask for card details and a onetime password sent via SMS to steal their money. Additionally, there are artificial intelligence (AI) generated scams to be on the lookout for.

"Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather, be afraid of the One who can destroy both soul and body in hell." (Mt 10:28)

Dear parishioners of St. Joseph,

We often worry about many things, like health, hunger, accidents, failures, and even death. However, these are things that only affect the body, not the soul. What is truly fearful is living an indulgent life deep in sin.

If we step back and consider these questions: what do you usually fear? How does this affect your spiritual life?


