

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners of St. Joseph,

On January 21, 2024, I was assigned by Cardinal DiNardo to be the new administrator of St. Joseph Church in Baytown. Upon learning that the church building had been out of service since October 27, 2023, and of the financial struggles St. Joseph was facing, I embraced this challenge with the grace of God, determined to walk with each one of St. Joseph's parishioners on this journey of restoring our church building and building a strong future for generations to come. Since the day I arrived at St. Joseph Church and witnessed your love and generosity, I have been confident that our shared goal of restoring our church will be successful. As a young priest and first-time pastor, I have learned so much from this experience and from each parishioner I have encountered—especially through the faith you express in your daily sacrifices. I am truly grateful for this opportunity to grow. It is hard to believe that I have now served as pastor of St. Joseph for over a year and a half.

By God's grace, the Archdiocesan financial assistance of 1.5 million for our church building, along with our Archbishop's approval of our Capital Campaign, have already been secured. After countless meetings at the Chancery, two major donor dinners for the feasibility study, and continued planning for the construction phase, the kick-off weekend for the Capital Campaign is now, August 15th and 16th weekend, as we are celebrating the Solemnity of the Assumption of our Blessed Virgin Mary. As we continue through the construction phases and grow as a parish community, we recognize that, although there may be growing pains, our church building will be restored to its beauty. More importantly, our parish community will be strengthened for future generations. With the guidance of our new Archbishop, Joe Vásquez, and his assistant, Bishop Italo Dell'Oro, we have been encouraged to restore a church that not only meets our current needs but also becomes a home for generations of our children to worship our Lord.

Our Building Committee and all the members of our Capital Campaign are now reaching out to ask for your generous contribution and commitment to the loan that the Archdiocese has graciously extended to St. Joseph for the restoration of our church. We have now reached the point where we need your support. We need everyone in the parish to get involved—by offering your time, talents, and treasures—to make this campaign a success. Through responsible stewardship of the gifts God has entrusted to each of us, we move one step closer to completing our parish facilities. I am confident in our success because of the strong faith and generous spirit our parishioners have demonstrated before—especially when we built the Family Life Center. It is my sincere hope that we will all be excited to contribute not only to our sacred place of worship at St. Joseph, but also to the heart of Baytown. St. Joseph is one of the oldest churches in the city and has been a spiritual home for over 100 years. I look forward to working together with all of you as we continue our collective effort to restore our church building and build a future of faith for generations to come.


