



### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

"Whoever listens to you listens to me. Whoever rejects you rejects me. And whoever rejects me rejects the one who sent me." (Luke 10:16)

### Dear parishioners of St. Joseph,

would like to post the one minute of Catechesis on this week's bulletin since some of our parishioners have asked me to have it written down.

Jesus gave authority to his disciples to teach in His name, and that those who listen to them are listening to Jesus Himself. While the Magisterium is not explicitly mentioned in the Bible, its role and significance in the Catholic Church can be understood through a comprehensive study of Scripture, awareness of church history, and a desire to follow Christ's command to seek first the kingdom of God.

Revelation, God's self-disclosure of Himself and His loving plan to save us, culminated in Jesus Christ. Before His ascension, Jesus commissioned the Apostles to preach the Gospel to the world. The Apostles fulfilled their mission by transmitting Sacred Tradition and Sacred Scripture. They did so through their actions, preaching, and especially, through the authority they granted to their successors, the bishops of the Church.

Tradition is the living transmission of the Church's doctrine, life, and worship, guided by the Holy Spirit. Scripture is God's Word as written down by the biblical authors under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. Thus, Tradition and Scripture are bound closely together. As Catholics, we accept and honor Tradition and Scripture equally.


### Here is how the Magisterium relates to them both.

The task of giving an authentic interpretation of the Word of God has been entrusted to the teaching office of the Church alone. This office is known as the Magisterium which consists of the bishops and the Pope (the Bishop of Rome).

- The Magisterium is not superior to the Word of God, but rather is its "servant."
- The Magisterium teaches only what has been handed down by the apostles.
- The Magisterium exercises its authority to the fullest when it defines dogmas. And Dogmas are statements of truths connected to Revelation of God.

Reflect: Would we be able to read and understand the Bible on your own? Does the Church's authoritative interpretation help us better understand Scripture? That's why our job is to offer our prayers to God as he shelters our Holy Father the Pope and our Bishops under the protection and guidance of the Holy Spirit.
