The letter to the pastor should be postmarked (or hand delivered) no later than February 19, 2021.

Letter to the Pastor

(Formal Letter Requesting to Receive the Sacrament of Confirmation)

Who writes the letter?

The letter is written by the person who wishes to receive the sacrament (the candidate). While the parents of the candidate may assist in its preparation, the letter's contents should be the sole work of the candidate.

To whom is the letter addressed?

The letter is written to the Pastor of St. Francis de Sales Catholic Church: Rev. James Gould (see next page for complete address)

What format should the letter take?

The letter is a formal document. It should be typed, or neatly handwritten in INK, on plain, unlined paper or stationery. The <u>confirmandi's name and signature</u> should be affixed to the letter.

PLEASE DO NOT USE PENCIL. PLEASE DO NOT USE NOTEBOOK PAPER RIPPED OUT OF A SPIRAL NOTEBOOK.

What should the letter contain?

The letter should address the following items:

- The candidate's statement of assurance that he/she feels well prepared to receive the sacrament of Confirmation
- A statement expressing WHY the candidate wishes to receive the sacrament of Confirmation
- A sentence formally requesting permission to receive the sacrament of Confirmation

When is the letter due?

The letter is due no later than February 19, 2021.

Where should the letter be sent?

Letters should be **sent to Father Gould at the parish office** at the address found at the top of the following page. (You may also personally drop off your letter <u>at the parish office during regular office hours</u>). Letters may also be dropped off at the Religious Education Office, to be delivered to Father Gould.
