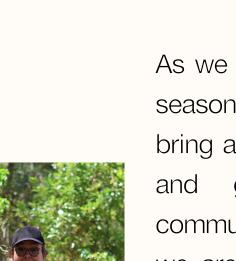
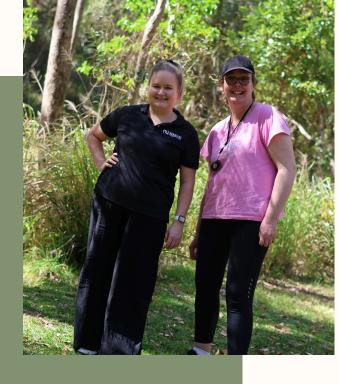


SEPTEMBER NEWSLETTER

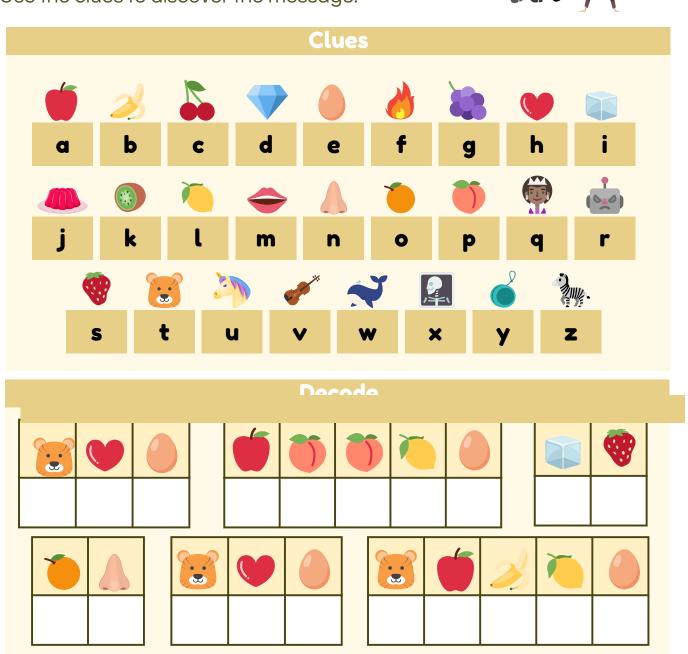

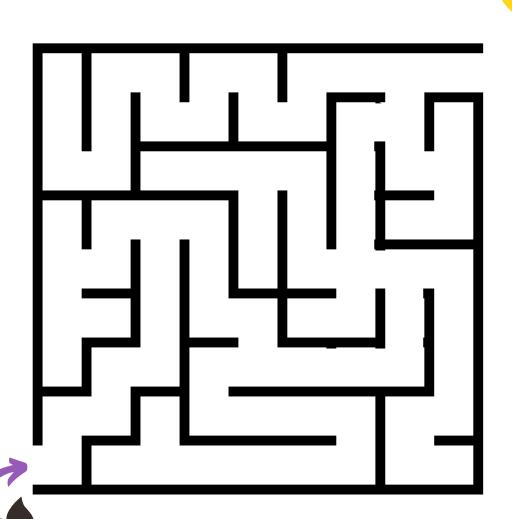

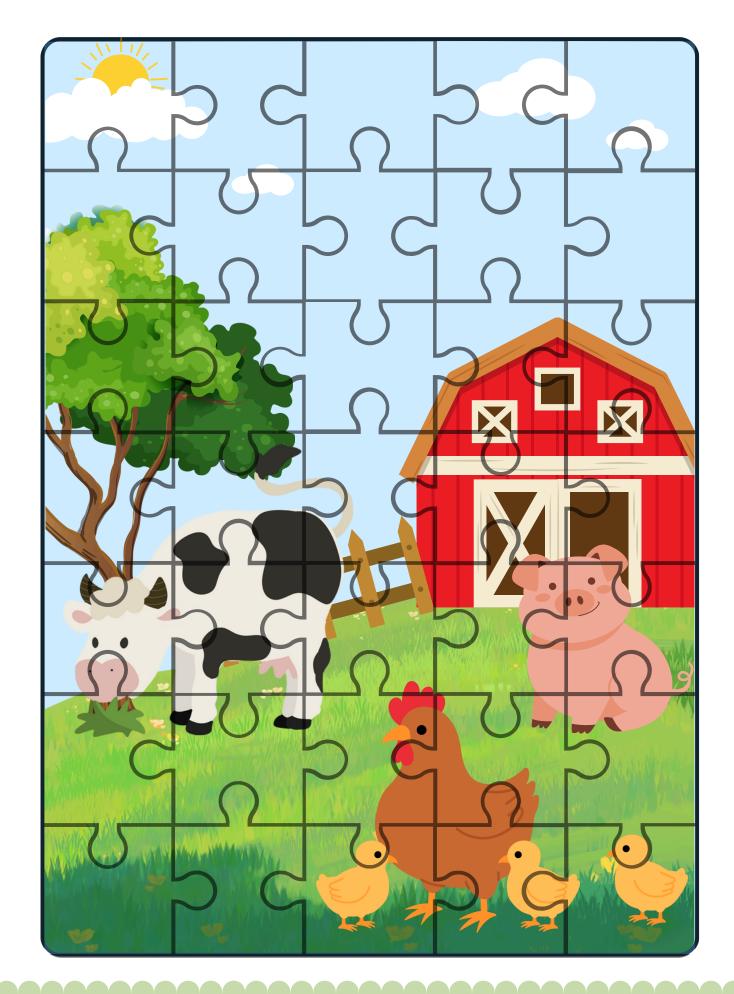

SUSHI

Ingredients

- 2 1/2 cups (540g) sushi rice
- 1/2 cup (125ml) rice vinegar
- 2 tbsp caster sugar
- 6 nori sheets
- 200g cooked chicken schnitzle, cut into 1cm-thick batons
- 1 avocado, halved, stoned, peeled, thinly sliced
- Light soy sauce, to serve
- Wasabi paste, to serve
- Pickled ginger, to serve

Instructions

- 1. Bring your rice to a boil
- 2. Cook until all the water is dissolved (roughly 12 min)
- 3.Let the rice cool in a bowl then combine vinegar, sugar and a pinch of salt in a small bowl
- 4. Combine mixture with rice until it's cold
- 5. Place a sushi mat on a clean surface with slats running horizontally. Place a nori sheet, shiny-side down, on the mat. Use wet hands to spread rice over the nori sheet, leaving a 3cm-wide border along the edge furthest away from you.
- 6. Place chicken and avocado along the centre of the rice. Hold filling in place while rolling the mat over to enclose rice and filling.
- 7. Use a sharp knife to slice sushi widthways into 1.5cm-thick slices. Place on serving dishes with soy sauce, wasabi and pickled ginger, if desired.
